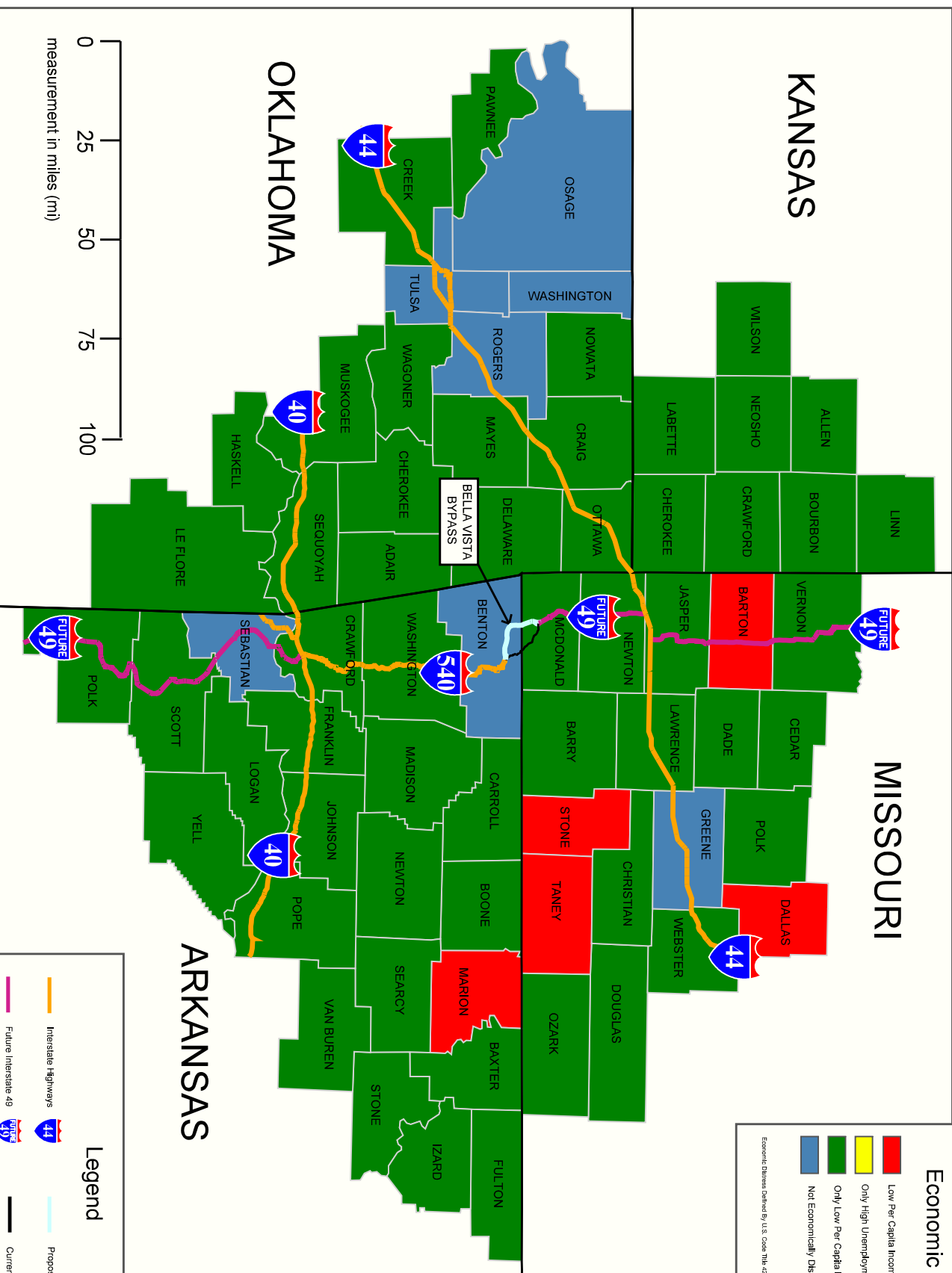


ECONOMICALLY DISTRESSED COUNTIES
