CHARACTERISTICS OF WORK

Under general supervision, this position is responsible for driving a heavy truck while dispensing paint on the highway.

EXAMPLES OF WORK

The following examples are intended only as illustrations of various types of work performed. No attempt is made to be exhaustive. Related, similar, or other logical duties are performed as assigned. The Department may require employees to perform functions beyond those contained in job descriptions. The Department may modify job descriptions based on Department needs. The Arkansas Department of Transportation is an "at will" employer.

- Assume duties and responsibilities of Striping Crew Supervisor and assist with paint crew duties when needed.
- Drive heavy multi-axle truck both straight and tapered while loaded with paint and beads.
- Read codes placed on highway by striping zoners so that no-passing zones begin and end in proper travel lanes.
- Perform preventive maintenance of assigned vehicle.
- Occasionally assist sign erection crews and work in sign shop or District.
- Perform cleanup duties.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Education and Experience: The educational equivalent to a diploma from an accredited high school. Experience with striping highways or installing pavement markings.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Thorough familiarity with all state highway routes. Ability to recognize and interpret zoning procedures. Ability to understand and implement sketches shown on channelization plans. Ability, to safely operate striping machine equipment as well as heavy equipment. Ability to assume duties and responsibilities of Striping Crew Supervisor when needed. Basic computer skills. Ability to read and speak the English language sufficiently to converse with the general public, to understand highway traffic signs and signals in the English language, to respond to official inquiries, and to make entries on reports and records. Ability to follow and communicate instructions.

Physical Requirements: Ability to climb, stand and walk for extended periods. Ability to lift and carry 50 pounds with or without reasonable accommodation.

Working Conditions: Ability to work outdoors in all types of weather conditions. Constant statewide travel ('Constant statewide travel' for this position means overnight travel three to four nights per week depending on project location with reimbursement for expenses).

Licenses, Registrations and Certifications: Valid Class A commercial driver's license with tanker ("N") endorsement.

A pre-employment drug/alcohol test will be conducted after a contingent offer of employment or transfer has been made, and prior to the candidate performing any work for the Department in that capacity. Internal applicants who are already in a safety-sensitive position will not be subject to pre-employment drug/alcohol testing; however, offers to internal applicants who are not in a safety-sensitive position will be contingent upon pre-employment drug/alcohol testing. Subject to additional drug/alcohol testing according to the provisions of the ARDOT Drug and Alcohol Testing Program.

("Accredited" means the educational institution or program is accredited by an accrediting organization recognized either by the United States Department of Education or by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation.)
