*CHARACTERISTICS OF WORK*

Under general supervision, this position is responsible for performing various manual labor duties assisting a striping crew in the operation of a pavement striping truck and to drive a 40-foot supply van tractor-trailer in emergencies.

*EXAMPLES OF WORK*

The following examples are intended only as illustrations of various types of work performed. No attempt is made to be exhaustive. Related, similar, or other logical duties are performed as assigned. The Department may require employees to perform functions beyond those contained in job descriptions. The Department may modify job descriptions based on Department needs. The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department is an "at will" employer.

- Drive pickup trucks while escorting striping machine.
- Assist in loading and unloading barrels of paint and 50 pound sacks of glass beads on supply van trailer.
- Flag traffic.
- Perform cleanup duties.
- Occasionally assist sign erection crews and work in sign shop or District.

*MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS*

Ability to read and speak the English language sufficiently to converse with the general public, to understand highway traffic signs and signals in the English language, and to respond to official inquiries, and to make entries on reports and records. Constant statewide travel. Valid Class A commercial driver's license with tanker ("N") endorsement. Experience in striping procedures preferred. A pre-employment drug/alcohol test will be conducted after a contingent offer of employment or transfer has been made, and prior to the candidate performing any work for the Department in that capacity. Internal applicants who are already in a safety-sensitive position will not be subject to pre-employment drug/alcohol testing; however, offers to internal applicants who are not in a safety-sensitive position will be contingent upon pre-employment drug/alcohol testing. Subject to additional drug/alcohol testing according to the provisions of the AHTD Drug and Alcohol Testing Program.
