- 1. **ACCEPTANCE AND REJECTION:** The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to accept bids in whole or in part (unless otherwise indicated by bidder), to waive any informalities in bids received, to accept bids on materials or equipment with variations from specifications where efficiency of operation will not be impaired, and to award bids to best serve the interest of the State.
- 2. **PRICES:** Unless otherwise stated in the Bid Invitation, the following will apply: (1) unit prices shall be bid, (2) prices should be stated in units of quantity specified (feet, each, lbs., etc.), (3) prices must be F.O.B. destination specified in bid, (4) prices must be firm and not subject to escalation, (5) bid must be firm for acceptance for 30 days from bid opening date. In case of errors in extension, unit prices shall govern. Discounts from bid price will not be considered in making awards.

- 1. <u>General</u>: Successful bidder shall furnish and install steel covers on ten (10) 2013 Ford F250 Extended Cab Pickups with short, wide beds (4 ea. 4WD and 6 ea. 2WD), owned by Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department. Trucks are not equipped with tailgate steps.
 - A. Trucks are to be picked up by Successful Bidder at AHTD Equipment and Procurement Division, 11302 Baseline Rd., Little Rock, Arkansas. After installation is complete trucks are to be delivered by the successful bidder to AHTD Equipment and Procurement Division, 11302 Baseline Rd., Little Rock, Arkansas.
 - B. If distance from Little Rock, Arkansas to bidder's installation facility exceeds a nominal radius of 200 miles, the vehicles must be transported rather than driven to and from the installation facility. The successful bidder will be responsible for the cost of transporting trucks to bidder's installation facility and back to AHTD Equipment and Procurement Division after installation is complete. Successful Bidder shall furnish proof of insurance that would cover the loss of trucks while in his possession.
- 2. Cover: Cover furnished shall be a heavy duty model recommended by the manufacturer for use as a work cover. Shall be all steel construction with no less than 17 gauge galvanized steel framing and no less than 26 gauge galvanized steel skin. Interior roof shall be insulated with foam insulation, or with a material which has equal insulating quality. Shall have safety tempered glass front window and two (2) lift type side doors approximately 20" high and 60" long (one on each side of cover). 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- 6. <u>Current Model</u>: Units furnished under this specification shall be the latest improved model in current production, as offered to commercial trade, built for the U.S. market, and shall be of quality workmanship and material. Machines manufactured for foreign markets will not be accepted. All equipment offered under this specification shall be new. Used, reconditioned, shopworn, demonstrator, prototype or discontinued models are not acceptable. Manufacturers of the units supplied must have been in the business of producing operational units for at least two years and must have recently sold similar units to domestic governmental agencies.
