## STANDARD BID CONDITIONS

#### H-14-252J

- 1. ACCEPTANCE AND REJECTION: The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to accept bids in whole or in part (unless otherwise indicated by bidder), to waive any informalities in bids received, to accept bids on materials or equipment with variations from specifications where efficiency of operation will not be impaired, and to award bids to best serve the interest of the State.
- 2. **PRICES:** Unless otherwise stated in the Bid Invitation, the following will apply: (1) unit prices shall be bid, (2) prices should be stated in units of quantity specified (feet, each, lbs., etc.), (3) prices must be F.O.B. destination specified in bid, (4) prices must be firm and not subject to escalation, (5) bid must be firm for acceptance for 30 days from bid opening date. In case of errors in extension, unit prices shall govern. Discounts from bid price will not be considered in making awards.
- BID BONDS AND PERFORMANCE BONDS: If required, a Bid Bond in the form of a cashier's check, certified check, or surety bond issued by a surety 3. company, in an amount stated in the Bid Invitation, must accompany bid. Personal and company checks are not acceptable as Bid Bonds. Failure to submit a Bid Bond as required will cause a bid to be rejected. The Bid Bond will be forfeited as liquidated damages if the successful bidder fails to provide a required Performance Bond within the period stipulated by AHTD or fails to honor their bid. Cashier's checks and certified checks submitted as Bid Bonds will be returned to unsuccessful bidders; surety bonds will be retained. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bond in an amount stated in the Bid Invitation and in the form of a cashier's check, certified check, or surety bond issued by a surety company, unless otherwise stated in the Bid Invitation, as a guarantee of delivery of goods/services in accordance with the specifications and within the time established in the bid. Personal and company checks are not acceptable as Performance Bonds. In some cases, a cashier's check or certified check submitted as a Bid Bond will be held as the Performance Bond of the successful bidder. Cashier's checks or certified checks submitted as Performance Bonds will be refunded shortly after payment has been made to the successful bidder for completion of all terms of the bid; surety bonds will be retained. Surety bonds must be issued by a surety company authorized to do business in Arkansas, and must be signed by a Resident Local Agent licensed by the Arkansas State Insurance Commissioner to represent that surety company. Resident Agent's Power-of-Attorney must accompany the surety bond. Certain bids involving labor will require Performance Bonds in the form of surety bonds only (no checks of any kind allowed). In such cases, the company issuing the surety bond must comply with all stipulations herein and must be named in the U.S. Treasury listing of companies holding Certificates of Authority as acceptable sureties on Federal Bonds and as acceptable reinsuring companies. Any excess between the face amount of the bond and the underwriting limitation of the bonding company shall be protected by reinsurance provided by an acceptable reinsuring company. - 4. TAXES: The AHTD is not exempt from Arkansas State Sales and Use Taxes, or local option city/county sales taxes, when applicable, and bidders are responsible to the State Revenue Department for such taxes. These taxes should not be included in bid prices, but where required by law, will be paid by the AHTD as an addition thereto, and should be added to the billing to the AHTD. The AHTD is exempt from Federal Excise Taxes on all commodities except motor fuels; and excise taxes should not be included in bid prices except for motor fuels. Where applicable, tax exemption certificates will be furnished by the AHTD.
- 5. "ALL OR NONE" BIDS: Bidders who wish to bid "All or None" on two or more items shall so stipulate on the face of bid sheet; otherwise, bid may be awarded on an individual item basis.
- 6. SPECIFICATIONS: Complete specifications should be attached for any substitution or alternate offered, or where amplification is necessary. Bidder's name must be placed on all attachments to the bid.
- 7. EXCEPTIONS TO SPECIFICATIONS: Any exceptions to the bid specifications must be stated in the bid. Any exceptions to manufacturer's published literature must be stated in the bid, or it will be assumed that bidder is bidding exactly as stated in the literature.
- 8. BRAND NAME REFERENCES: All brand name references in bid specifications refer to that commodity or its equivalent, unless otherwise stated in Bid Invitation. Bidder should state brand or trade name of item being bid, if such name exists.
- 9. FREIGHT: All freight charges should be included in bid price. Any change in common carrier rates authorized by the Interstate Commerce Commission will be adjusted if such change occurs after the bid opening date. Receipted common carrier bills that reflect ICC authorized rate changes must be furnished.
- 10. SAMPLES, LITERATURE, DEMONSTRATIONS: Samples and technical literature must be provided free of any charge within 14 days of AHTD request, and free demonstrations within 30 days, unless AHTD extends time. Failure to provide as requested within this period may cause bid to be rejected. Samples, literature and demonstrations must be substantially the same as the item(s) being bid, unless otherwise agreed to by AHTD. Samples that are not destroyed will be returned upon request at bidder's expense. Samples from successful bidders may be retained for comparison with items actually furnished.
- 11. **GUARANTY:** Unless otherwise indicated in Bid Invitation, it is understood and agreed that any item offered or shipped on this bid shall be newly manufactured, latest model and design, and in first class condition; and that all containers shall be new, suitable for storage or shipment and in compliance with all applicable laws relating to construction, packaging, labeling and registration.
- 12. BACKORDERS OR DELAY IN DELIVERY: Backorders or failure to deliver within the time required may constitute default. Vendor must give written notice to the AHTD, as soon as possible, of the reason for any delay and the expected delivery date. The AHTD has the right to extend delivery if reasons appear valid. If reason or delivery date is not acceptable, vendor is in default.
- 13. DEFAULT: All commodities furnished will be subject to inspection and acceptance by AHTD after delivery. Default in promised delivery or failure to meet specifications authorizes the AHTD to cancel award or any portion of same, to reasonably purchase commodities or services elsewhere and to charge full increase, if any, in cost and handling to defaulting vendor. Applicable bonds may be forfeited.
- 14. - 7. The successful bidder(s) shall make all deliveries in accordance with individual orders placed by stockroom supervisors of each district within ten (10) days after notice by telephone.
- 8. In the event the successful bidder finds that he will be unable to supply all items noted on an individual order within 10 days, he shall immediately notify the Stockroom Supervisor, and in such event the Department shall have the right to purchase the item (or items) under separate purchasing procedures with the option of holding the contract vendor responsible for any excess cost of the item(s).
- 9. Invoicing information noted on the Bid Forms is intended to aid the supplier and the Department. Payment will be made on each individual order as promptly as possible after receipt of invoice. Invoices mailed to the Central Office location in Little Rock will cause delay.
- 10. In the event of unsatisfactory delivery and/or material furnished, the Department reserves the right to cancel this contract upon giving to the vendor fifteen (15) days notice of its intention to terminate the contract. Upon the giving of such notice, the contract shall automatically terminate as of the date in said notice. Otherwise, the prices bid shall remain in effect for the contract period.
- 11. <u>Cooperative Purchasing</u>: Procedures are being developed to permit other tax-supported entities\* in Arkansas (cities, counties, state agencies, school districts, etc.) to purchase from this Contract on an individual basis under the same specifications and conditions, and at the pricing set forth by each vendor, all at the discretion of each vendor in each case. Prices could be reduced by a vendor for minor alterations in conditions (changing minimum order quantities, etc.) as agreed by both parties, but could not be raised above the contract bid price under any circumstances. Vendors would not be required to sell to any such entity under this Contract, and those entities would not be obligated to purchase from the Contract.

Should these procedures be approved during the term of this contract, each entity wishing to purchase from the Contract would make contact directly with the appropriate vendor(s). The Highway Department would remain "out of the loop" for such transactions: all contact, orders, invoices, payments, etc. regarding such transactions must take place exclusively between the tax-supported entity and the vendor. The Department would be held harmless of any and all liability arising from such transactions.

- 1. <u>Scope</u>. These specifications cover rock salt for ice removal.
- 2. **<u>DESCRIPTION</u>**. Rock salt used for ice removal shall be produced by crushing natural deposits of sodium chloride. Material produced by recrystalization of salt solutions will not be accepted.
- 3. <u>CHEMICAL COMPOSITION</u>. The rock salt shall conform to the following requirements as to chemical composition:

Sodium chloride (as NaCl), Minimum percent 95.0%

4. **<u>GRADING</u>**. The rock salt shall conform to the following gradation requirements as determined by laboratory sieves (U.S. Standard Sieve Series):

Sieve Designation	Percent Passing
3/8 inch	100
No. 4	85-100
No. 8	15-35
No. 30	0-15

- 5. <u>PACKAGING AND MARKING</u>. The rock salt shall be delivered in bags or sacks containing not more than 50 pounds each or in bulk when requested. When delivery is made in bags or sacks, the name of the manufacturer and net weight shall be legibly marked on each container. The percentage of sodium chloride guaranteed by the manufacturer shall be noted on the shipping report or legibly marked on the containers. When delivery is by bulk, the manufacturer shall furnish certified analysis giving sodium chloride content of the rock salt furnished.
- 6. <u>SAMPLING AND TESTING</u>. The rock salt shall be sample and tested in accordance with AASHTO M 143 and AASHTO T 27. If the material is sampled after delivery, it is understood that a 0.5 percent (%) variation in content of sodium chloride from the chemical composition prescribed in Section 3 shall be permissible.
- 7. **<u>REJECTION</u>**. The rock salt may be rejected if it fails to conform to any of the requirements of these specifications. The material shall be rejected if not received in a free flowing usable condition.

Type 2 - Concentrated flake, pellet or other granular calcium chloride.

- 5. <u>PACKAGING AND MARKING</u>. The calcium chloride shall be delivered in moisture proof bags containing not more than 80 pounds each. The name of the manufacturer, name of the product, net weight, and percentage of calcium chloride guaranteed by the manufacturer shall be legibly marked on each container. Bags shall be delivered dry and intact.
- 6. <u>SAMPLING AND TESTING</u>. The calcium chloride shall be sampled and tested in accordance with A.A.S.H.O. Method T 143. If the material is sampled after delivery, a 3 percent variation in content of CaC12 from that marked on each container as required in Sections 3 and 5 will be permissible.
- 7. <u>REJECTION</u>. The calcium chloride may be rejected if it fails to conform to any of the requirements of these specifications or if it has become caked or sticky in shipment.
