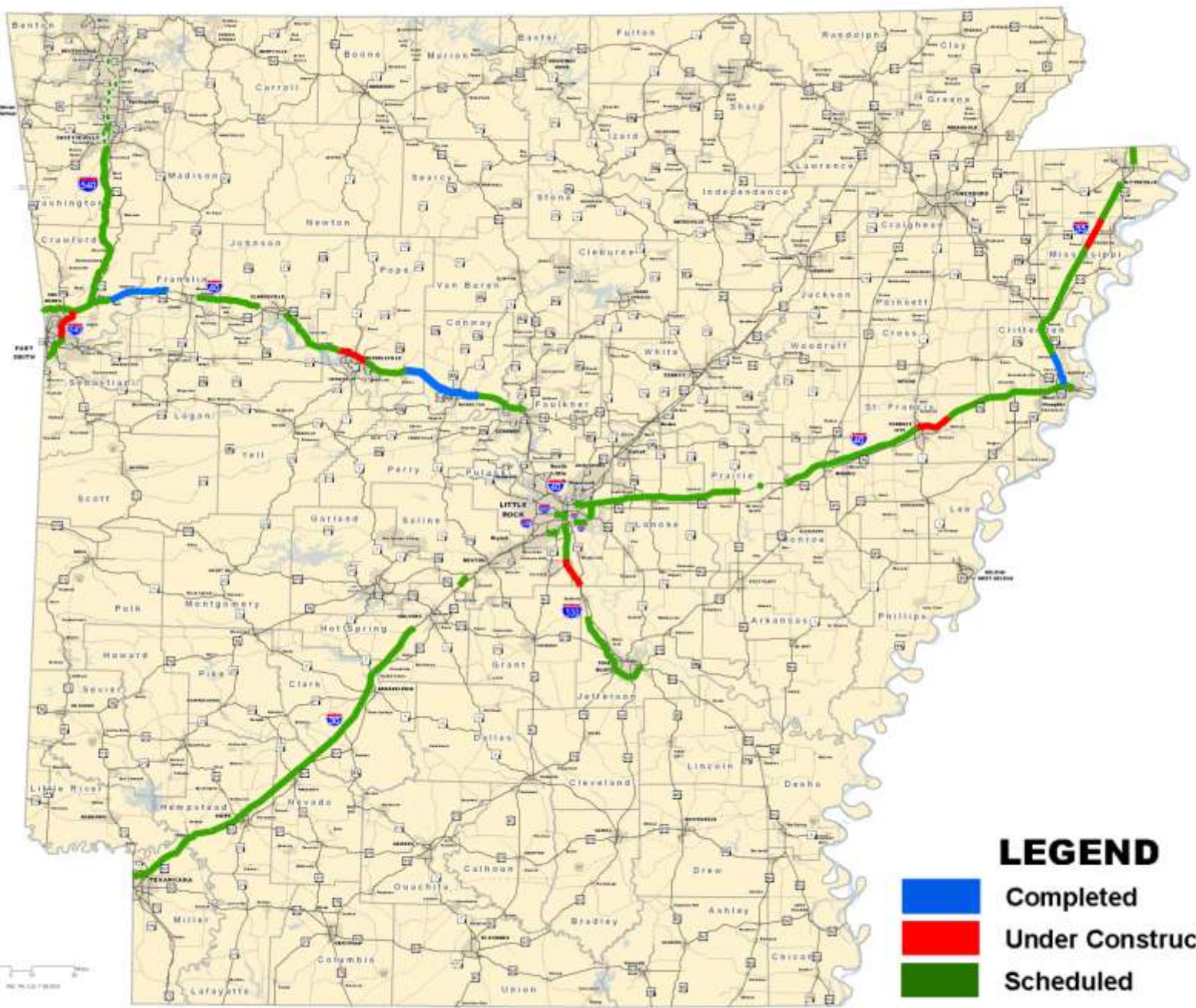

Interstate Rehabilitation Program Job Status

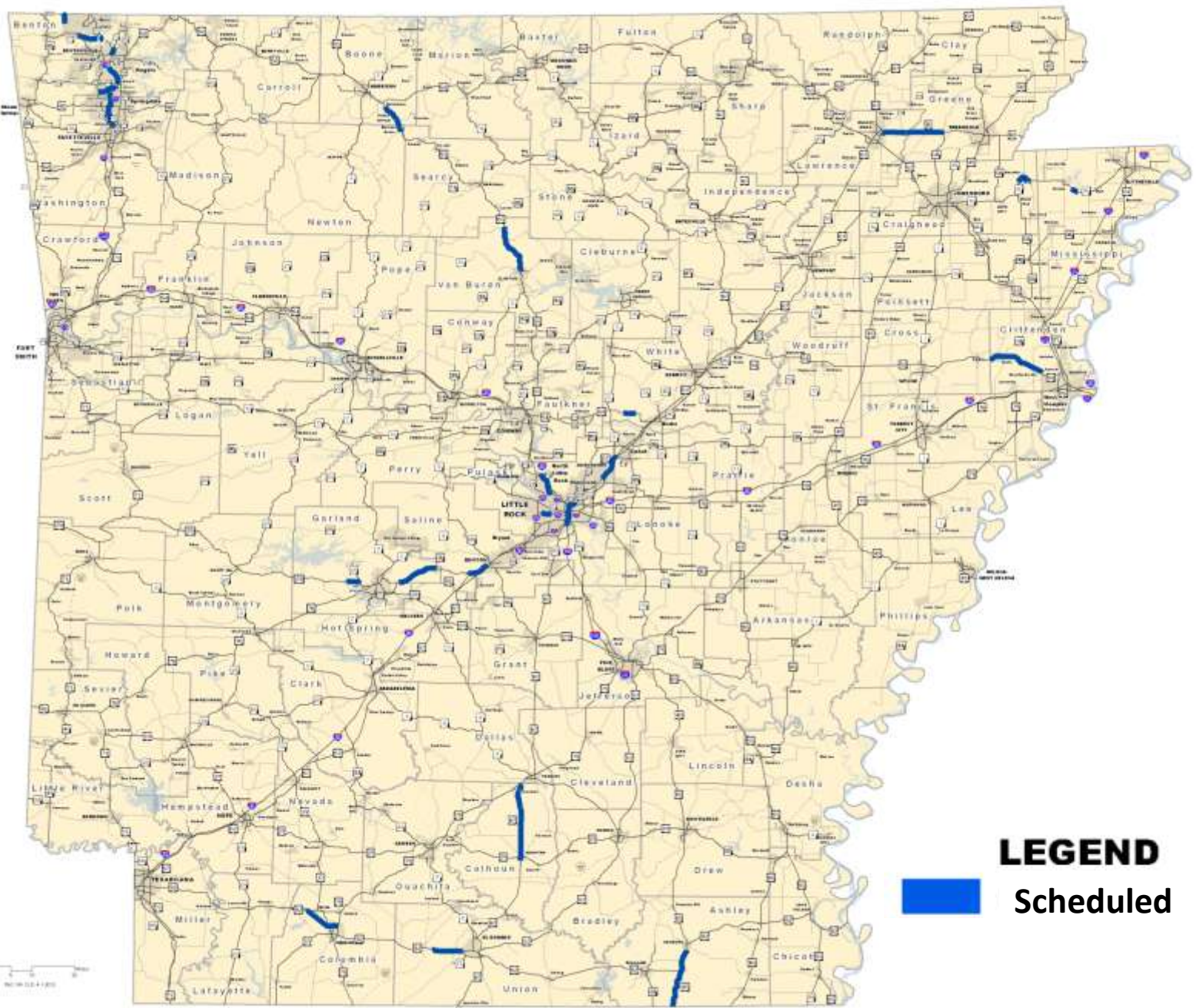

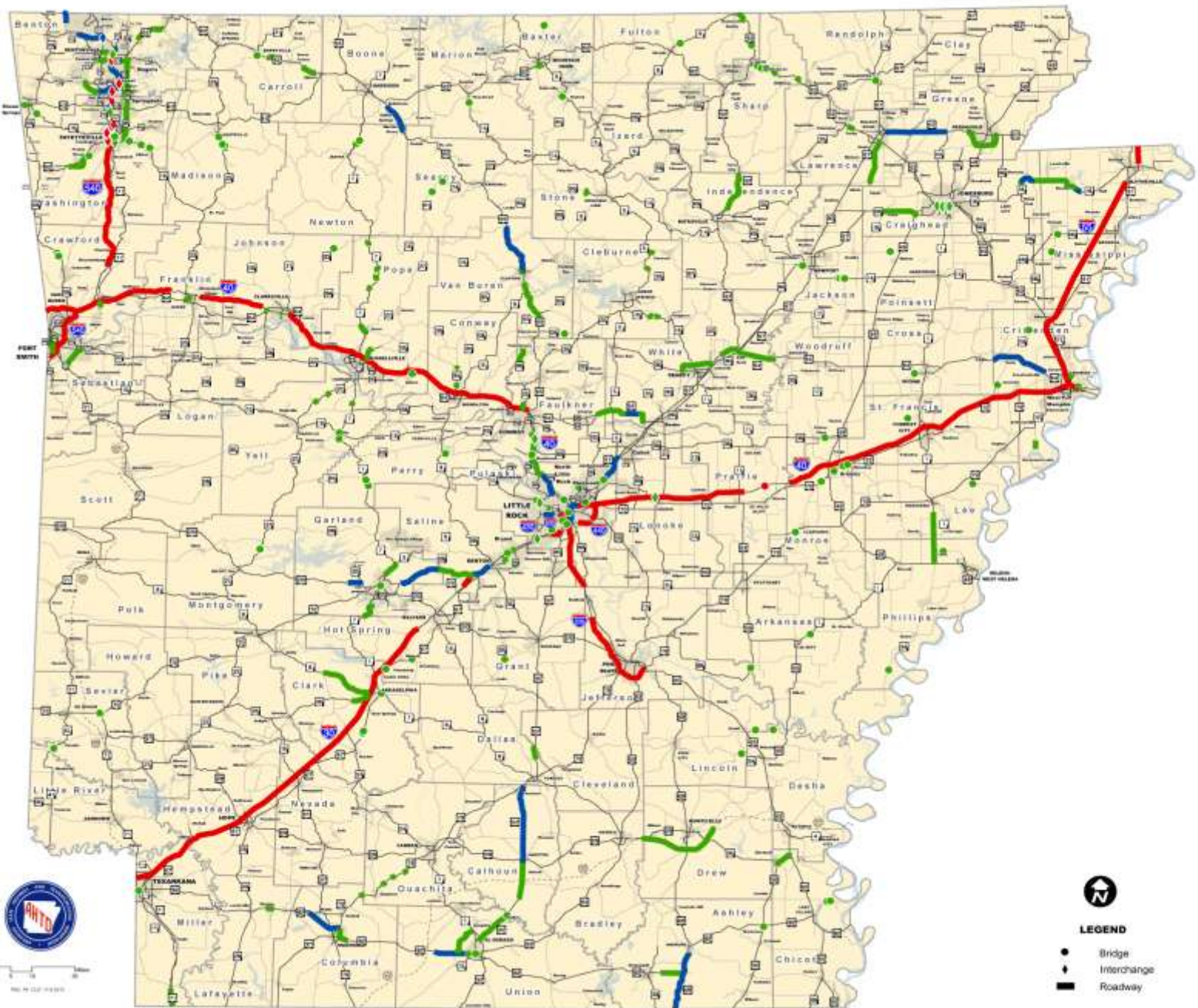

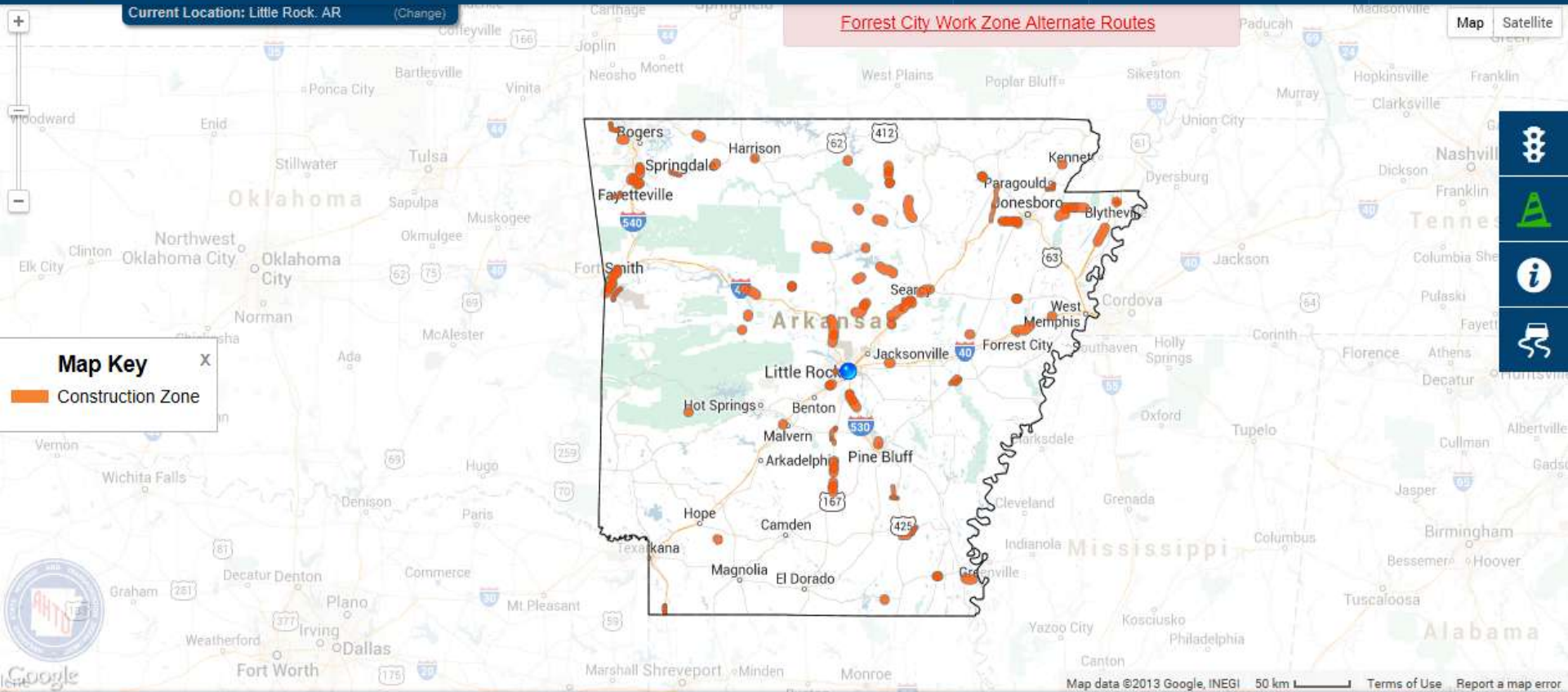

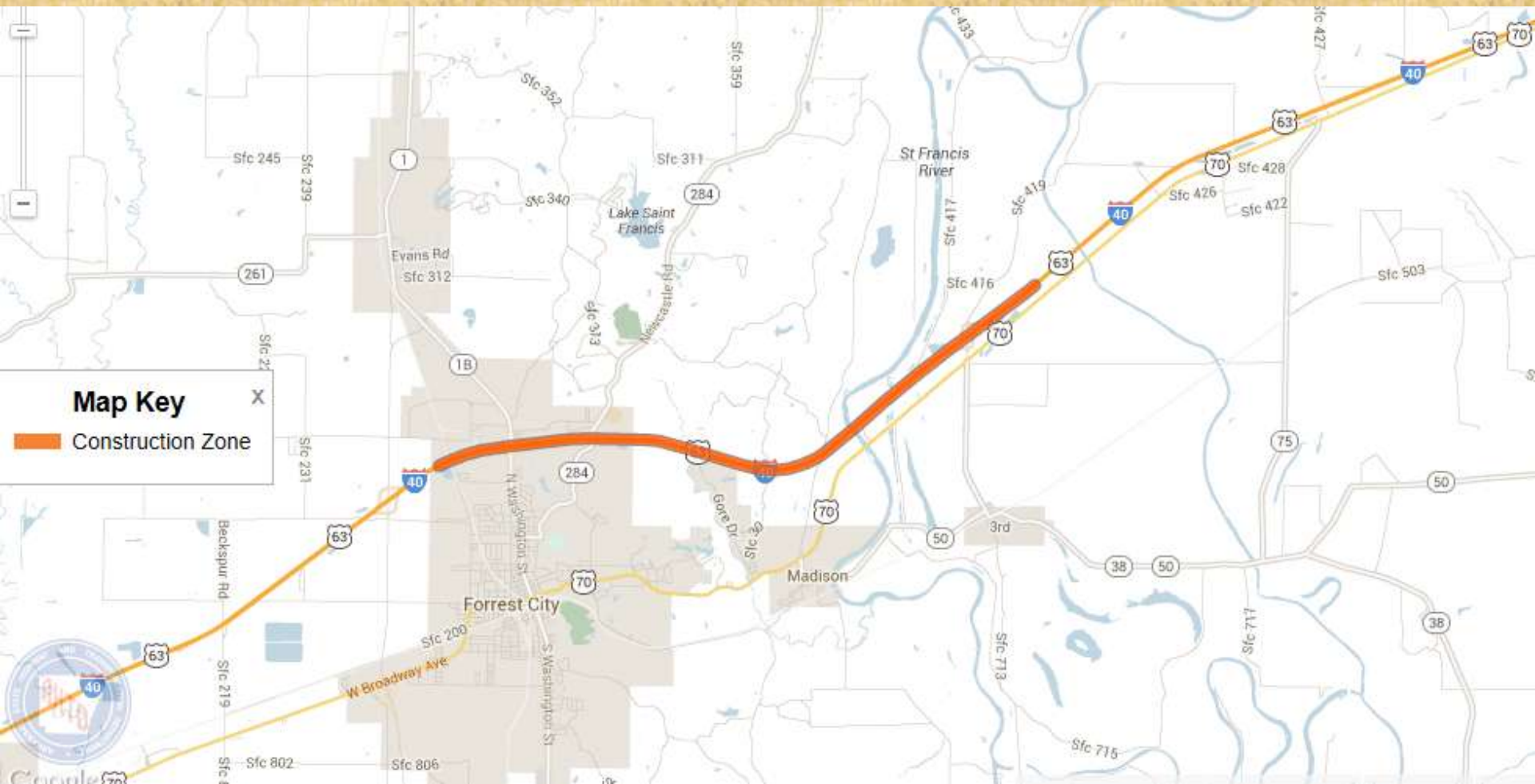
Forrest City Work Zone Alternate Routes

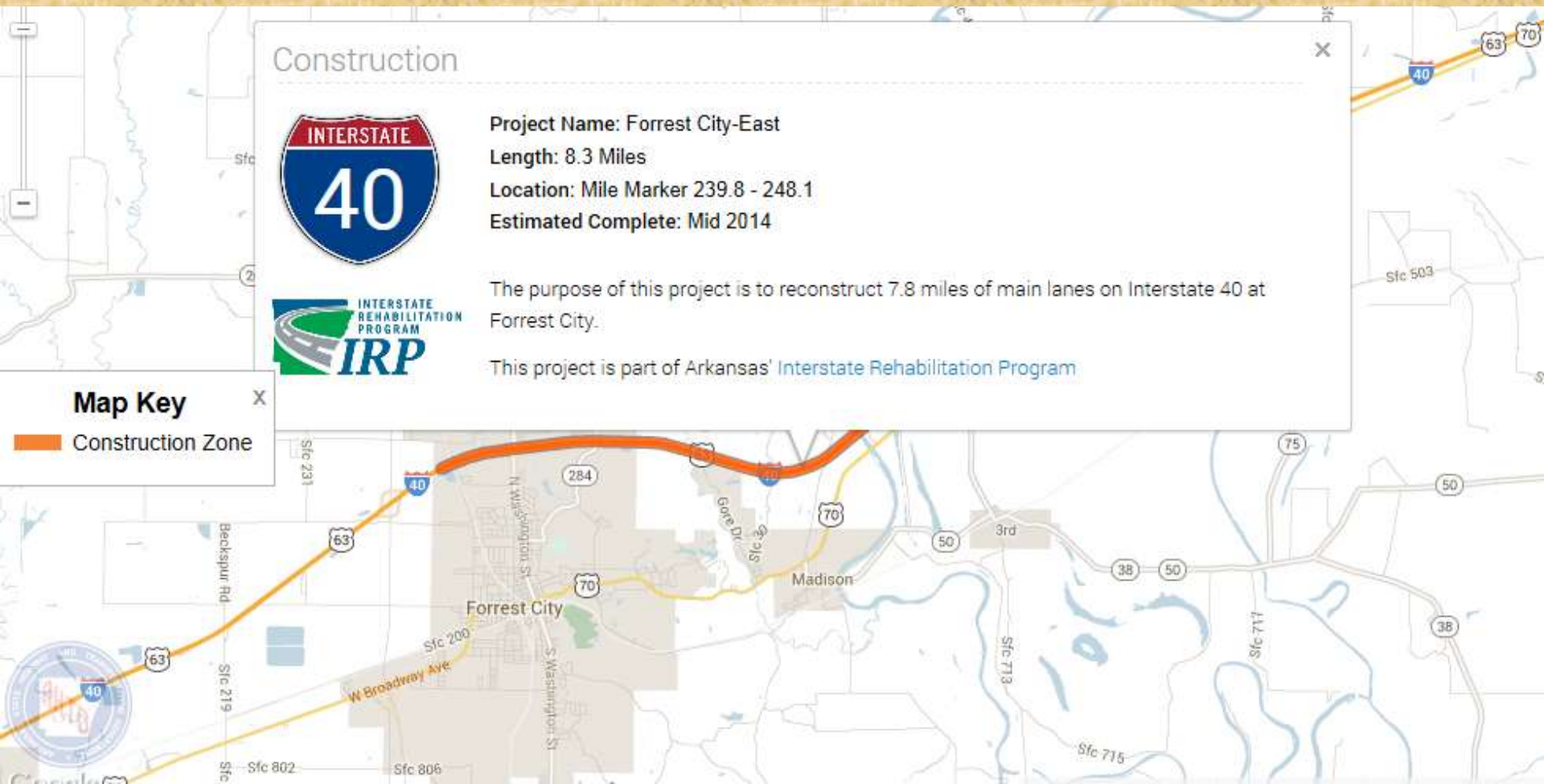


The purpose of this project is to reconstruct 7.8 miles of main lanes on Interstate 40 at Forrest City.

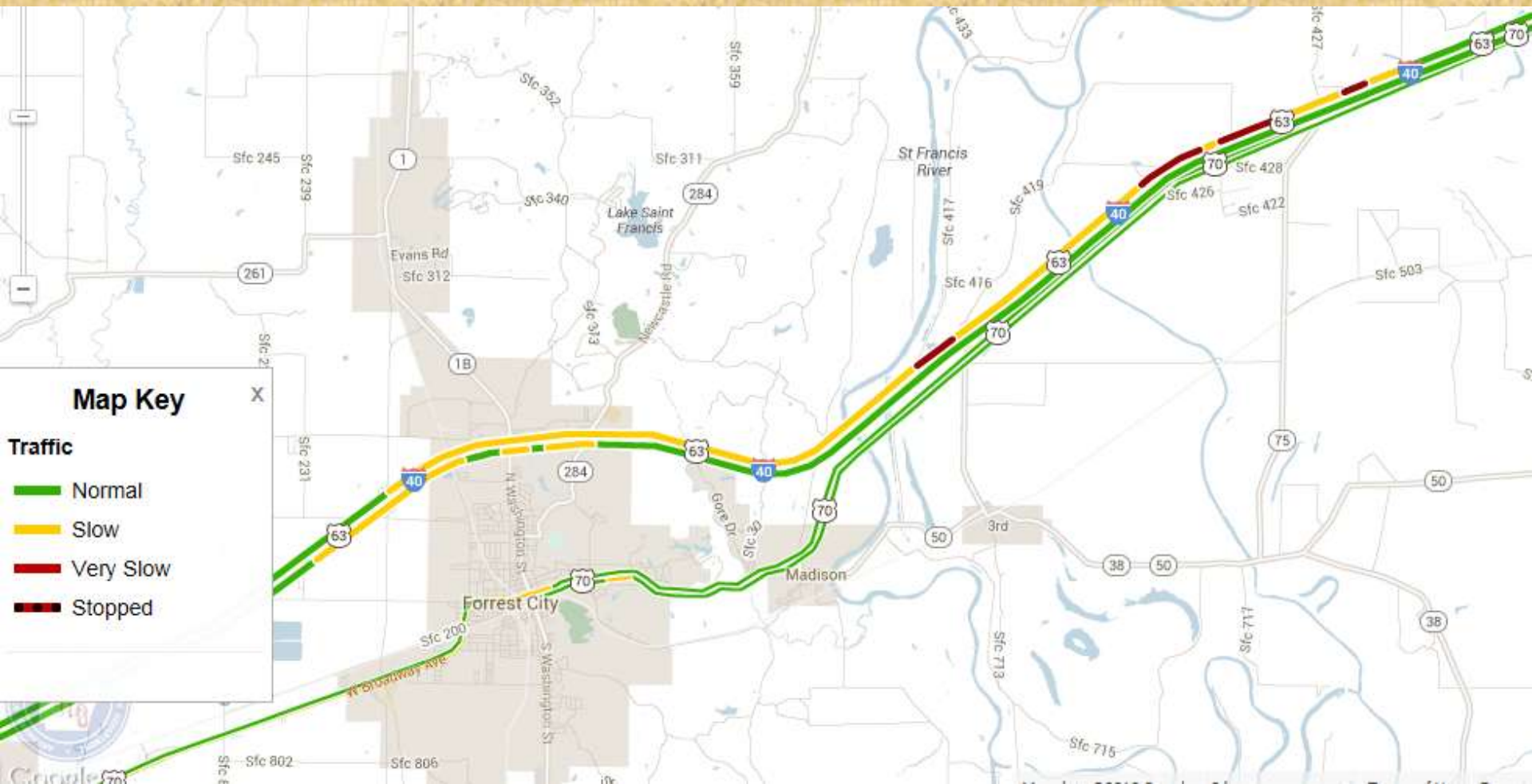

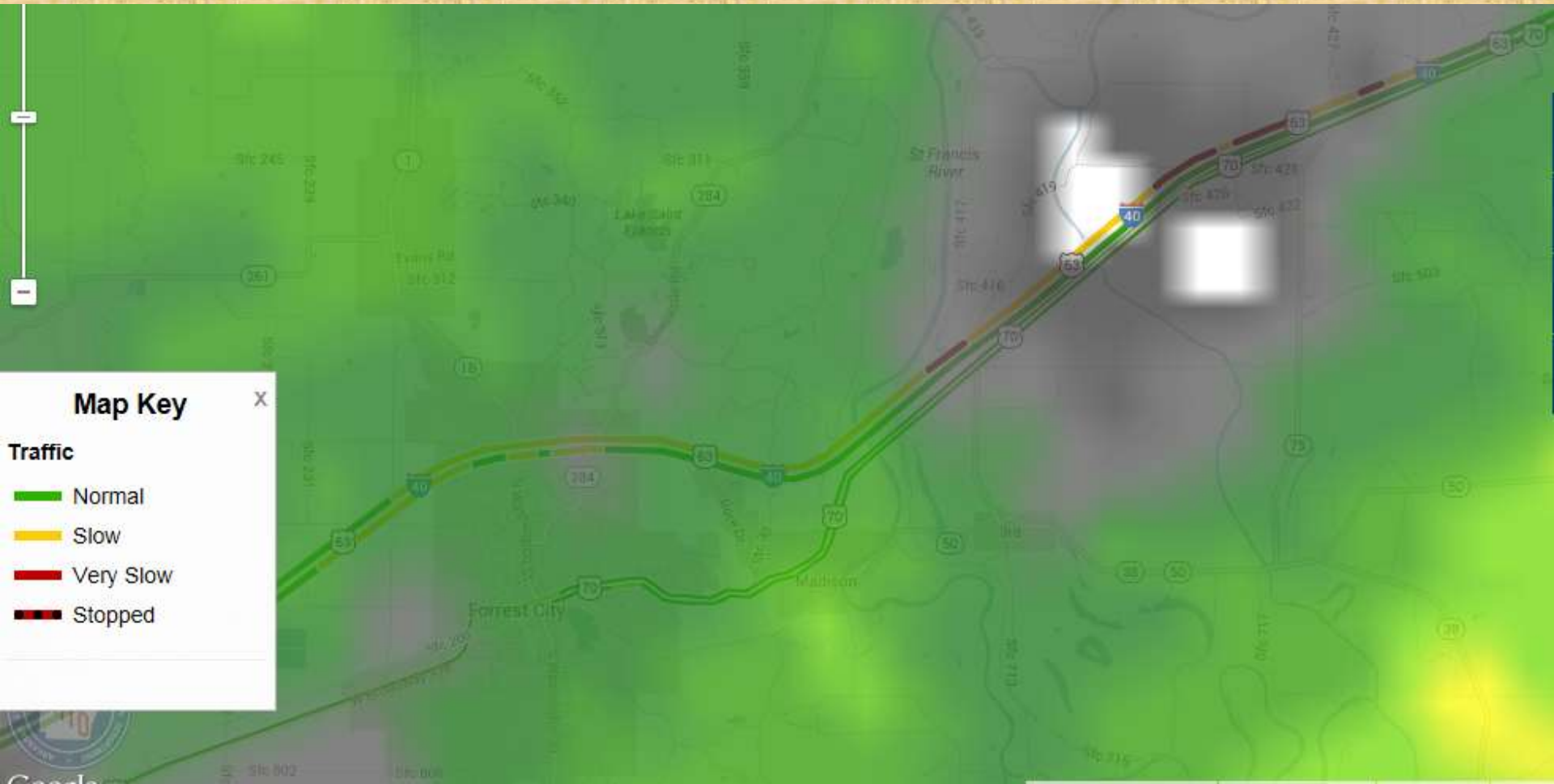

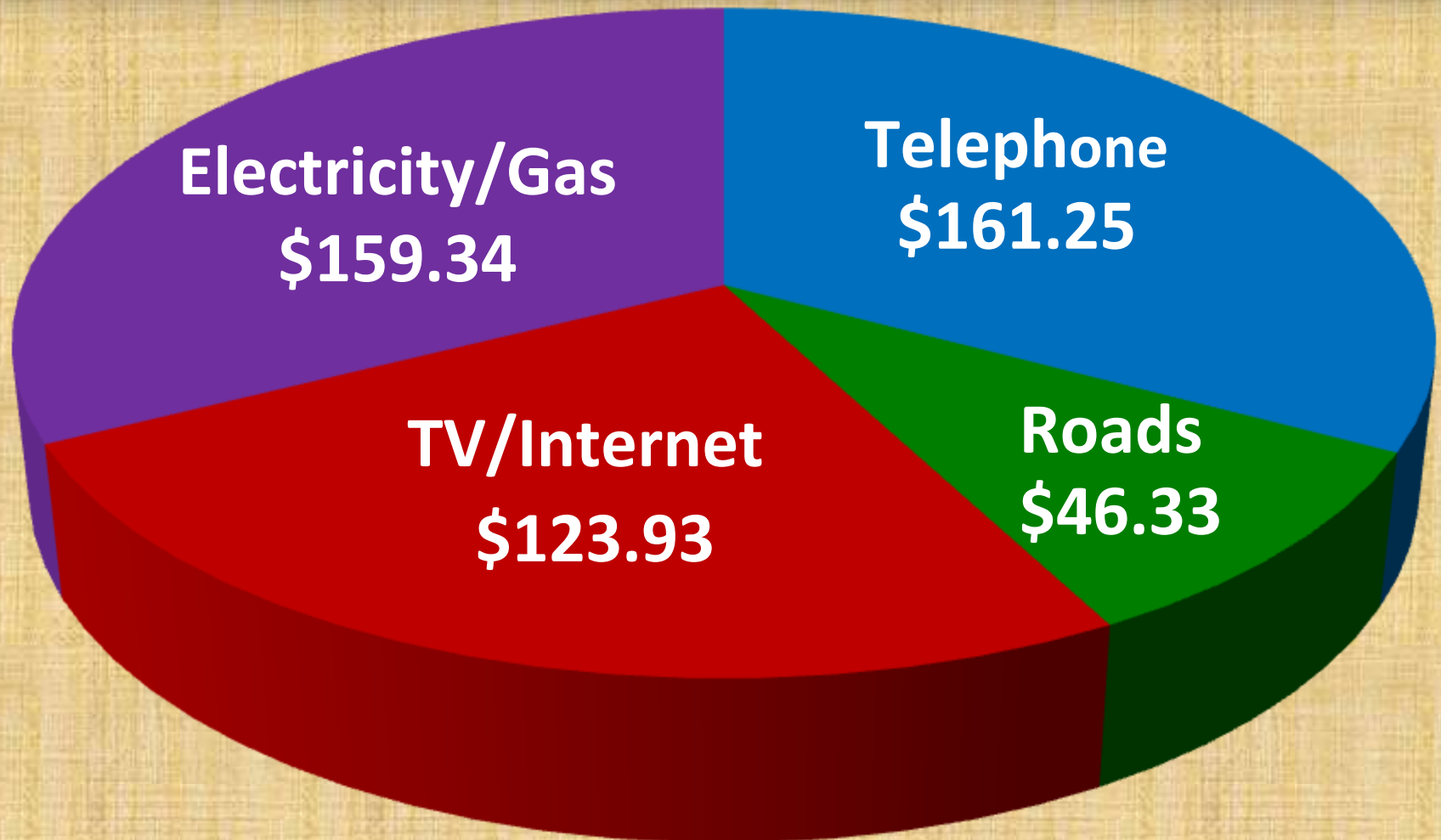
