Highway Conditions in Arkansas Interstate Highways - 2014




Needs vs. Revenue








HIGHWAY TRUST FUND

Highway-to-Transit flex and highway safety obligations suspended in FY 2015.





ILLUSTRATIVELY, SHORING UP HTF WOULD NOT PRESENT AN UNREASONABLE BURDEN

- Average household pays \$46 in federal and state gas tax per month. This is less than per monthly cost of:
 - Electricity and gas: \$160
 - Cell phone: \$161
 - Cable and internet access: \$124
- For example, a 10-cent increase in the federal gas tax translates to \$1.15 more for the average driver per week—an action that would fix the Highway Trust Fund shortfall





What is the Cost of No Action?

 Driving on inadequate roads in Arkansas costs drivers \$2 billion annually

 In central Arkansas, the cost is \$1700 per motorist

What is the Benefit of Action? Spending Economic Return










State General Revenues vs. AHTD Net Highway Revenues

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


