

Year	Description
1991	Congress Designated Corridor 18 and Corridor 20 as High Priority Corridors of National Significance:
	 ✓ Corridor 18 - Indianapolis to Memphis ✓ Corridor 20 - Laredo to Texarkana
1993	Corridor 18 Extended from Memphis to Houston Connecting to Corridor 20 I-69 Steering Committee Established - Arkansas Lead State
1995	The National Highway System Designation Act added Specific Language that Corridor 18 would serve Mississippi and Arkansas and that Corridors 18 and 20 were "Future Parts of the Interstate System"
1998	Congress Further Expands Corridor 18, Officially Designates the Route as Interstate 69 and adds Connections to Pine Bluff and Chicago
2007	USDOT Selected Interstate 69 as one of six Corridors of the Future







I-69 Statistics

- 2,730 miles
- Estimated Cost to Complete \$30 Billion
- 32 "Segments of Independent Utility" (SIUs)
- Innovative Financing Study Complete
 - "Based on the limited availability of resources for I-69 at the state level, <u>it appears that significant Federal assistance will be</u> <u>required to advance development of the I-69 Corridor</u>, particularly given the high cost of the bridges across the Ohio and Mississippi Rivers that are keys to ensuring connectivity throughout the corridor."

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

- Preferred Alignment Identified
- 184 miles
- Estimated Cost to Complete - \$3.0 Billion
- 4 "Segments of Independent Utility" (SIUs)
- Federal Earmarked Funds - \$300 Million










- Environmental Studies Complete / Preferred Alignment Selected
- 42 miles
- Right-of-Way Purchased for 4-lane Interstate Facility
- Initial Construction 2 Lanes
- Current Estimate is \$616 million for the ultimate 4-lane Interstate Facility
