





## **GROWTH OF THE HIGHWAY SYSTEM**




# **Average Annual Highway User Revenue Distribution**





# ARDOT Highway Revenue at 14.4% of General Revenue



Are you satisfied with the condition of the existing highway system?




# Road User Related Tax Revenue (SFY 2016)
