The City of Fayetteville is seeking bids from vendors for the construction of Sain Street. The contract consists of approximately 1950 L.F. of roadway construction from Frontage Road to Joyce Boulevard, along with a 320 L.F. new bridge over Mud Creek and associated structures, construction of associated earthwork, curb and gutter, sidewalk and enclosed drainage. Additionally, an approximately 780 L.F. of 12' wide concrete trail will be constructed along with concrete block gravity retaining wall and lighting. Minor utility service work will need to be completed as part of the roadway construction. A signal pole and mast are to be constructed, with associated items at the southwest corner of Joyce Boulevard and Vantage Drive. Bidding documents, plans, plan holders, and addenda shall be obtained at the City of Fayetteville Purchasing Division's electronic bidding platform at [www.fayetteville-ar.gov/bids](http://www.fayetteville-ar.gov/bids). All bids shall be received by **Wednesday November 4, 2020 before 2:00 PM, local time** utilizing the electronic bidding software, OR by submitting a sealed bid at the City of Fayetteville, Purchasing Division address listed below. Submitting a bid electronically is strongly encouraged. A public bid opening will be conducted shortly after the deadline at City Hall and livestreamed at <https://www.youtube.com/user/cityoffayettevillear>. No late bids shall be accepted. The City of Fayetteville shall not be responsible for lost or misdirected bids, or failure of bidder's technical equipment.

A non-mandatory Pre-Bid meeting will be held Tuesday **October 20, 2020 at 10:00 AM** virtually. Information regarding the pre-bid meeting is available on the project page on the City's electronic bidding platform. All interested parties are encouraged to attend.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a cashier's check from a bank doing business in the State of Arkansas or a corporate bid bond in an amount not less than five (5) percent of the amount bid. A one hundred percent (100%) performance and payment bond is required with the contract awarded and shall be file marked by the Washington County Circuit Clerk's Office upon receipt to the City. The manufacturer shall provide stamped drawings from a licensed engineer or architect in the State of Arkansas. Attention is called to the fact that the minimum prevailing wage rates for each craft or type of worker and the prevailing wage rate for overtime work as determined by the Arkansas Department of Labor applies to a contract award of \$75,000 or more.

In an effort to understand hardships our vendors and suppliers are facing in relation to the current COVID-19 situation, the Purchasing Division will take feedback from plan holders and interested parties to understand the current impact to vendors operations.

Pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated §22-9-203 The City of Fayetteville encourages all *qualified* small, minority and women business enterprises to bid on and receive contracts for goods, services, and construction. Also, City of Fayetteville encourages all general contractors to subcontract portions of their contract to *qualified* small, minority and women business enterprises.



A State of Arkansas Contractor's License is not required to bid on the project; however, no contractor shall submit a bid prior to submitting an initial application (which does not require a full audit) for licensure, and no construction contract shall be executed until the successful bidder has furnished an appropriate license issued by the State of Arkansas Contractor's Licensing Board.

"Buy America" provisions apply to this project. The Arkansas Department of Transportation's Standard Specifications Section 106 has requirements and restrictions for "Buy America". Also, 23 CFR § 635.410 has all of the federal requirements for "Buy America". This means that any permanent steel in the project must be manufactured in the US.

This Project is a Federal-Aid contract. This project requires wage rates to be paid according to Davis-Bacon Federal Wage Rates. The percentage goal for Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Participation in this project is 10.0%

The City of Fayetteville hereby notifies all bidders that this contract is subject to applicable labor laws, non-discrimination provisions, wage rate laws and other federal laws including the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938. The Work Hours Act of 1962 and Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 also apply.

The City of Fayetteville reserves the right to waive irregularities, reject bids, and postpone the award of any Contract for a period of time which shall not exceed beyond sixty (60) days from the bid opening date.
