# **INTEROFFICE MEMORANDUM**

The Environmental Division has reviewed the referenced project and it falls within the definition of a Tier 2 Categorical Exclusion under 23 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 771.117, and the ARDOT/FHWA Memorandum of Agreement on the processing of Categorical Exclusions. A public hearing will not be offered for this project.

The purpose of this project is to replace a weight restricted bridge on Highway 54 in Lincoln County. Total length of the project is 0.019 mile. The attached figure illustrates the project location.

Existing Highway 54 consists of two 10-foot wide travel lanes with no shoulders. The existing bridge (#M1006) has a 24' x 32' concrete deck with asphalt overlay on steel girders, with reinforced concrete abutments and wing walls. The bridge has a sufficiency rating of 61.4. There is no right of way of record.

Proposed improvements include a triple 11' x 5' x 72' reinforced concrete box culvert with two 10-foot wide paved travel lanes and 4-foot wide shoulders (2' paved). The proposed average right of way width will be 125 feet. Approximately 0.76 acre of right of way will be required for this project.

There are no relocations, endangered species, wetlands, floodplains, or environmental justice issues associated with this project. No impacts to cultural resources are anticipated; concurrence from the State Historic Preservation Officer is attached. Field inspections found no evidence of existing underground storage tanks or hazardous waste

deposits. Approximately 0.28 acre of Prime Farmland will be converted to highway right of way. Form NRCS-CPA-106 is attached.

Design data for this project is as follows:

Based upon the ARDOT's *Policy on Highway Traffic Noise Abatement*, a noise analysis is not required for this project. This project does not involve added capacity, construction of new through lanes or auxiliary lanes, changes in the horizontal or vertical alignment of the roadway or exposure of noise sensitive land uses to a new or existing highway noise source.

Impacts to Mills Bayou include the construction of a reinforced concrete box culvert, which replaces the existing bridge, and a temporary detour constructed adjacent to the south side of the existing structure. Construction of the proposed project should be allowed under terms of a Section 404 Nationwide Permit 14 for Linear Transportation Projects as defined in the Federal Register 82 (4): 1860-2208. Impacts to Mills Bayou will be less than 0.1 acre and will not require a preconstruction notification for coverage under this permit.




