Tier 1 Categorical Exclusion

After appropriate environmental review, it has been determined that the subject job is a Tier 1 Categorical Exclusion as described by the ArDOT/FHWA Programmatic Agreement on Categorical Exclusion Documentation and Processing. Public hearings will not be offered for these projects.

The purpose of this project is to preserve and rehabilitate various bridges in Districts 2, 3, 6 and 7. The project will polymer overlay 22 bridges across eight counties in the above districts. Table 1 lists the bridges, their locations, and type of work involved. The State Historic Preservation Officer's clearance is attached. No endangered species will be affected by the proposed project. No Section 404 permits will be required.

The project will not involve relocations, endangered species, prime farmlands, wetlands, underground storage tanks, hazardous materials, any environmental justice issues, or cultural resources. This project has been determined to generate minimal air quality impacts for Clean Air Act criteria pollutants and has not been linked with any special mobile source air toxic concerns.

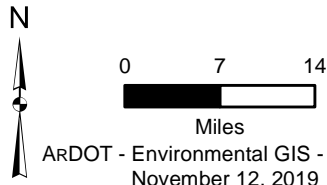
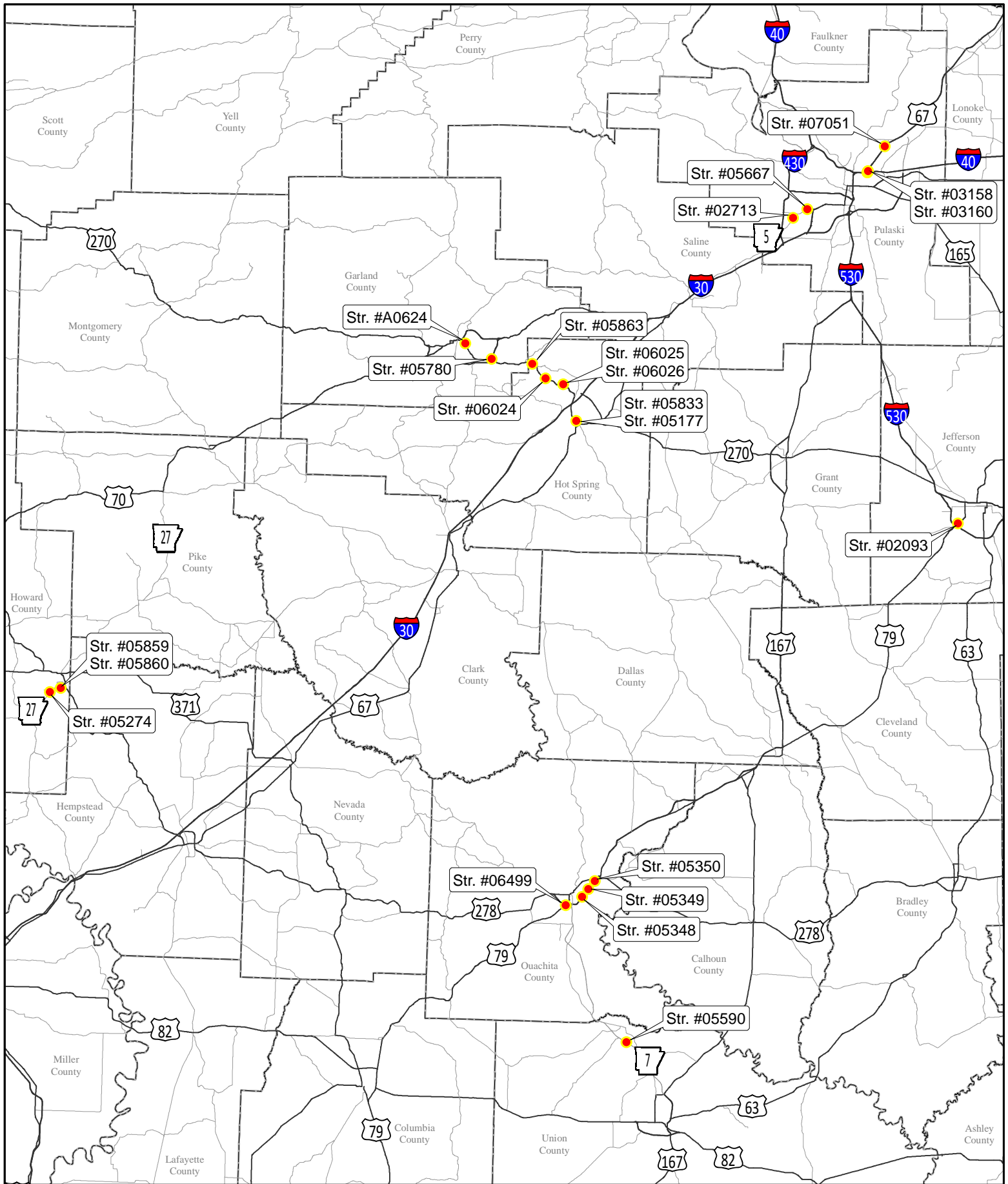


