Route I-40, Sections 31 and 32 Conway and Faulkner Counties Tier 1 Categorical Exclusion

The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate 6.2 miles of Interstate 40 between Menifee and Conway in Conway and Faulkner Counties. Work will include mill and overlay of the roadway, polymer overlay of five bridges, and hydro-demolition of two bridges. All work will take place within existing right of way. A project location map is attached.

The project will not involve relocations, prime farmlands, wetlands, underground storage tanks, hazardous materials, any environmental justice issues, or cultural resources. The Cultural Resources clearance is attached. This project has been determined to generate minimal air quality impacts for Clean Air Act criteria pollutants and has not been linked with any special mobile source air toxic concerns.

The official species list obtained through the US Fish and Wildlife Service's (USFWS) Information for Planning and Consultation website lists the Indiana Bat (*Myotis sodalis*), Piping Plover (*Charadrius melodus*), and Rattlesnake-master Borer Moth (*Papaipema eryngii*) as protected species potentially occurring in the proposed project area. Based on the lack of habitat, scope of the project, and distance to known species it has been determined that the proposed project will have "no effect" on all listed species.

The project will not have a discharge of dredged or fill material into waters of the United States; therefore, a Section 404 permit will not be required.



This job proposes to mill and overlay an existing 6.174 miles of road surface with asphalt pavement on I-40 in Conway and Faulkner Counties. This includes resurfacing on ARDOT Bridge Numbers A6428, B6428, 07055, A3919, and B3919, which are not 50 years old; and bridges A6869 and B6869 which are considered not eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP). The project will require no new right-of-way (ROW).

A records check at the Arkansas Archeological Survey shows two sites (3FA0040 and 3FA0109) near the ROW. The two sites are not adjacent to the ROW and will not be impacted by this project. No recorded historic structures are shown on the AHPP structure database in or near the ROW. No cultural indicators were found on the 1840 General Land Office maps within or near the project. The 1936 Conway & Faulkner road maps show structures along the existing Hwy. 64. If structures were present to the north, they were likely destroyed during the construction of the interstate.

All work will be within the existing ROW and the extremely limited scope of the project does not have the potential to affect any undisturbed land surfaces or potential historic properties. This project is subject to the 1999 MOA and falls under the exempted Work Category "Resurfacing." The project is not considered an undertaking and requires no further work or Section 106.

Tier 1 Categorical Exclusion Re-evaluation

A Tier 1 Categorical Exclusion was completed for the subject project on August 13, 2019. Since that time, the design was changed to include clearing of vegetation 30' from the existing asphalt shoulder along the entire length of the project. All work will still take place within existing right of way. A project location map is attached.

This project will remain a Tier 1 Categorical Exclusion as defined by the ARDOT/FHWA Programmatic Agreement on Categorical Exclusions Documentation and Processing. After review of the design change, the Environmental Division identified no additional environmental impacts.

The official species list obtained through the US Fish and Wildlife Service's (USFWS) Information for Planning and Consultation website lists the Indiana bat (*Myotis sodalis*), Piping Plover (*Charadrius melodus*), Eastern Black Rail (*Laterallus jamaicensis*), Red Knot (*Calidris canutus rufa*), Whooping Crane (*Grus americana*), and the rattlesnake-master borer moth (*Papaipema eryngii*) as protected species potentially occurring in the proposed project area.

Based on the project being adjacent to the right of way, limited impact area, and distance to known species, it is our determination that the proposed project will

have "no effect" on the Piping Plover, Eastern Black Rail, Red Knot, Whooping Crane, and the rattlesnake-master borer moth.

Due to these project design changes, consultation on the Indiana bat was necessary. Based on the limited impact area, project being adjacent to the right-of-way, implementation of BMP's, and winter clearing restrictions, it is our determination that the proposed project "may affect, but is not likely to adversely affect" the Indiana bat. The proposed action is within the scope of the Programmatic Biological Opinion for Transportation Projects within the Range of the Indiana Bat and Northern Long-eared Bat. The USFWS concurrence letter dated December 10, 2019 is attached.


The project is covered under the original cultural resources clearance memo dated May 1, 2019. A checklist of all potential environmental impacts is attached.

The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (Service) has reviewed your re-initiation request, assessment, and determinations for Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDoT) Job Number Job # BB0808 Hwy. 65 - West (F) in Conway and Faulkner Counties, Arkansas. This action may rely on the revised February 5, 2018, Programmatic Biological Opinion (BO) for federally funded or approved transportation projects that may affect the Indiana Bat (*Myotis sodalis*) and/or Northern Long-eared Bat (NLEB) (*Myotis septentrionalis*). We received your re-initiation request and the associated Project Submittal Form on December 9, 2019.

The project was described and assessed as follows (abbreviated):

The Arkansas Department of Transportation is proposing to place mill & inlay, poly overlay on bridges and tree removal within ROW to facilitate roadway exposure to the sun during the winter months

FHWA, FRA, FTA Programmatic Biological Opinion for Transportation Projects within the Range of the Indiana Bat and Northern Long-eared Bat (PBO) determination key within IPaC provided a determination of may affect, but is not likely to adversely affect (NLAA) for the endangered Indiana Bat (*Myotis sodalis*) and/or the threatened Northern Long-eared Bat (*Myotis septentrionalis*).

The following species may occur in your project area and are not covered by this determination: Eastern Black Rail, *Laterallus jamaicensis ssp. jamaicensis* (Proposed Threatened); Piping Plover, *Charadrius melodus* (Threatened); Rattlesnake-master Borer Moth, *Papaipema eryngii* (Candidate); Red Knot, *Calidris canutus rufa* (Threatened); and Whooping Crane, *Grus americana* (Experimental Population, Non-Essential)

The Service has received your concurrence verification letter and request to verify that the Proposed Action may rely on the concurrence provided in the revised February 5, 2018, FHWA, FRA, FTA Programmatic Biological Opinion for Transportation Projects within the Range of the Indiana Bat and Northern Long-eared Bat (PBO) to satisfy requirements under Section 7(a)(2) of the Endangered Species Act of 1973 (ESA) (87 Stat. 884, as amended; 16 U.S.C 1531 et seq.).

Based on the information you provided, you have determined that the Proposed Action is within the scope and adheres to the criteria of the PBO, including the adoption of applicable avoidance and minimization measures, may affect, but is not likely to adversely affect (NLAA) Indiana Bat and Northern Long-Eared Bat. The Service concurs that this action may rely on the PBO.

Please keep in mind that you must report any departures from the plans submitted; results of any surveys conducted; or any dead, injured, or sick listed bats that are found to this office. If this project is not completed within one year of this letter, you must update your determination and resubmit the required information.

Furthermore, due to the limited size of the area being affected along existing roadway and bridge crossings, adjacent right-of-way, the distance to known species locations or hibernacula, the implementation of BMPs, winter clearing, and the standard provisions for stream sediment control and water quality conservation measures, the Service agrees with your determinations assessment for all other listed species identified. This concurrence concludes your ESA Section 7 responsibilities relative to these species for this action.
