Tier 1 Categorical Exclusion Re-evaluation

A Tier 1 Categorical Exclusion was completed for the referenced project on June 1, 2017. Since that time, design modifications have resulted in changes to the original scope. The project now consists of intersection improvements to Hwy. 367/Hwy. 319/Griffin Rd. by widening Hwy. 367 to include left turn lanes and a northbound right turn lane. This will be accomplished by notch and widen with curb and gutter. A new traffic signal will be installed with a railroad preemption interconnect system to communicate with the upgrades to the Union Pacific Railroad crossing system on Hwy. 319. A section of Hickory Street will be removed and permanently barricaded. The project is located within the city limits of Ward, Arkansas. A project location map is attached.

Total length of the project is 0.18 mile. Approximately 0.6 acres of new right of way will be needed for the project. The Environmental Division has reviewed these changes, and no additional environmental impacts were identified. A Section 404 Permit will not be required for construction of this project.

The official species list obtained through the US Fish and Wildlife Service's Information for Planning and Consultation website lists the Eastern Black Rail (*Laterallus jamaicensis*), Piping Plover (*Charadrius melodus*), and Red Knot (*Calidris canutus rufa*) as protected species potentially affected by the proposed project. Based on the lack of habitat, scope of the project, and distance to known species, it is our determination that the proposed project will have "no effect" on all listed species.



## Dear Mr. Fleming:

The staff of the Arkansas Historic Preservation Program (AHPP) reviewed the Project Identification Form (PIF) for the above-referenced job in Lonoke County. As described, the proposed undertaking entails replacing a railroad crossing traffic signal on Highway 319 and improving the intersection of Highways 319 and 367 at Griffin Street in Lonoke. The proposed area of potential effects (APE) for the undertaking is .6 acres.

The investigation recorded a single architectural resource within the APE. Property 1 is a wood-framed service station built prior to 1963. The AHPP concurs that Property 1 is not eligible for inclusion in the National Register.

Based on the provided information and the results of the field investigation, the AHPP concurs with the finding of **no historic properties affected pursuant to 36 CFR § 800.4(d)(1)**. In the event of a post-review discovery of historic properties within the area of potential effects, please contact the AHPP and other consulting parties in accordance with 36 CFR § 800.13(b)(3).

Tribes that have expressed an interest in the area include the Cherokee Nation (Ms. Elizabeth Toombs), the Chickasaw Nation (Ms. Karen Brunso), the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma (Ms. Madison Currie), the Jena Band of Choctaw Indians (Ms. Alina J. Shively), the Muscogee (Creek) Nation (Ms. Corain Lowe-Zepeda), the Osage Nation (Dr. Andrea Hunter), the Quapaw Nation (Mr. Everett Bandy), and the Shawnee Tribe (Ms. Tonya Tipton). We recommend consultation in accordance with 36 CFR § 800.2(c)(2).


