Tier 1 Categorical Exclusion

The purpose of this project is to replace a bridge on Highway 69 over Village Creek in Greene County. Total length of the project is approximately 0.14 mile. The attached figure illustrates the project location.

The existing roadway consists of two 11' wide paved travel lanes with 3' wide shoulders (1' paved). The existing bridge (M3808) is a 35' x 116' structure in poor condition.

Proposed improvements include constructing a new bridge with approaches consisting of two 11' wide paved travel lanes with 4' wide shoulders (2' paved). The project could acquire up to 8.0 acres of additional right of way.

Design data for this project is as follows:

There are no relocations, environmental justice issues, or wetlands associated with this project. No impacts to cultural resources are anticipated; concurrence from the State Historic Preservation Officer is attached. Field inspections found no evidence of existing underground storage tanks or hazardous waste deposits. Up to 0.8 acre of Prime Farmland may be converted to highway right of way. Form NRCS-CPA-106 is attached. This project has been determined to generate minimal air quality impacts for Clean Air Act criteria pollutants and has not been linked with any special mobile source air toxic concerns.

Based on the ARDOT's noise policy, a noise analysis is not required for this project. The project does not involve added capacity, construction of new through lanes or auxiliary lanes, substantial changes in the horizontal or vertical alignment of the roadway, or exposure of noise sensitive land uses to a new or existing highway noise source.

The official species list obtained through the US Fish and Wildlife Service's (USFWS) Information for Planning and Consultation (IPaC) website lists Indiana bat (*Myotis sodalis*), Fat Pocketbook (*Potamilus capax*), Rabbitsfoot (*Theliderma cylindrica*), Scaleshell (*Leptodea leptodon*) and pondberry (*Lindera melissifolia*) as species potentially occurring in the project area. The project area is outside the Indiana bat consultation area provided by the Arkansas Ecological Services Field Office; therefore, it is presumed the project will not affect this species. This project will have "no effect" on the remaining four species due to the lack of suitable habitat, limited scope of the project, and distance to known species occurrences.

The project will have a discharge of dredged or fill material into waters of the United States associated with the bridge; therefore, a Section 404 permit will be required. The project should be authorized by Nationwide Permit 14 for Linear Transportation Projects as defined in Federal Register 82(4): 1860-2008.

Greene County participates in the National Flood Insurance Program and lies within the Zone A, Special Flood Hazard Area. The final project design will be reviewed to confirm that the design is adequate and that the potential risk to life and property are minimized. Adjacent properties should not be impacted nor have a greater flood risk than existed before construction of the project. None of the encroachments will constitute a substantial floodplain encroachment or risk to property or life.


After appropriate environmental review, it has been determined that the subject job is a Tier 1 Categorical Exclusion as described by the ARDOT/FHWA Programmatic Agreement on Categorical Exclusion Documentation and Processing. A public hearing will not be offered for this project.

The staff of the Arkansas Historic Preservation Program (AHPP) reviewed the Project Identification Form for the above-referenced job in Sections 18 and 19, Township 16 North, Range 6 East in Greene County. The undertaking entails replacement of Bridge Number M3808. Bridge Number M3808 is not eligible for the National Register (AHPP Tracking Number 103003).

Based on the provided information and the results of the field investigation, the AHPP concurs with the finding of no historic properties affected pursuant to 36 CFR § 800.4(d)(1). In the event of a post-review discovery of historic properties within the area of potential effects, please contact the AHPP and other consulting parties in accordance with 36 CFR § 800.13(b)(3).

Tribes that have expressed an interest in the area include the Delaware Nation (Ms. Nekole Alligood), the Osage Nation (Dr. Andrea Hunter), the Quapaw Nation (Mr. Everett Bandy), and the Shawnee Tribe (Ms. Tonya Tipton). We recommend consultation in accordance with 36 CFR § 800.2(c)(2).
