Tier 1 Categorical Exclusion

After appropriate environmental review, it has been determined that the subject job is a Tier 1 Categorical Exclusion as described by the ARDOT/FHWA Programmatic Agreement on Categorical Exclusion Documentation and Processing. A public hearing will not be offered for this project.

The purpose of this project is to replace the overpass bridge (#A3224) on Highway 15 crossing Interstate 40 in Lonoke County. Total length of the project is 0.33 mile. A project location map is attached.

The existing 308'x42' bridge will be replaced by a bridge constructed on new location adjacent to the existing structure. The existing roadway consists of two 10-foot wide paved travel lanes with 10-foot wide paved shoulders. Proposed improvements include two 12-foot wide travel lanes with 8-foot wide paved wide shoulders. Up to 0.1 acre of additional right of way may be required for this project.

The project will not involve relocations, underground storage tanks, hazardous materials, floodplains, any environmental justice issues, or cultural resources. This project has been determined to generate minimal air quality impacts for Clean Air Act criteria pollutants and has not been linked with any special mobile source air toxic concerns. Up to 0.1 acre of Prime Farmland may be impacted. Form NRCS-CPA-106 and the State Historic Preservation Officer clearance are attached.

Based on the ARDOT noise policy, a noise analysis is not required for this project. The bridge replacement will not involve adding capacity, substantially changing the roadway alignment, or exposing noise sensitive land uses to traffic noise sources. In compliance with federal guidelines, local authorities will not require notification.

The official species list obtained from the US Fish and Wildlife Service's Information for Planning and Consultation website identified the Piping Plover (*Charadrius melodus*), Eastern Black Rail (*Laterallus jamicensis*), Red Knot Calidris (*Calidris canutus*) and Whooping Crane (*Grus Americana*) as federally listed species potentially occurring within the project area. Due to the lack of suitable habitat and distance to known species occurrences, it has been determined that the proposed project will have "no effect" on the aforementioned federally listed species.


Total impacts to waters of the United States are estimated at less than 0.1 acre. Construction should be allowed under the terms of a Section 404 Nationwide Permit 14 for Linear Transportation Projects as defined in Federal Register 82 (4):1860-2008. A pre-construction notification is not required.
