Tier 1 Categorical Exclusion

After appropriate environmental review, it has been determined that the subject job is a Tier 1 Categorical Exclusion as described by the ARDOT/FHWA Programmatic Agreement on Categorical Exclusion Documentation and Processing. A public hearing will not be offered for this project.

The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate 4.72 miles of Interstate 55 from Lake David to the Mississippi County Line in Crittenden County. Work will include an Ultra-Thin Bonded Wearing Course overlay on the roadway and polymer overlay on three bridges. All work will take place within existing right of way. A project location map is attached.

The project will not involve relocations, prime farmlands, wetlands, underground storage tanks, hazardous materials, any environmental justice issues, or cultural resources. This project has been determined to generate minimal air quality impacts for Clean Air Act criteria pollutants and has not been linked with any special mobile source air toxic concerns. The State Historic Preservation Officer clearance is attached.

The official species list was obtained through the US Fish and Wildlife Service's Information for Planning and Consultation website and lists the following species Job Number 110799 Tier 1 Categorical Exclusion Page 2 of 2

as potentially occurring in the project area: Eastern Black Rail (*Laterallus jamaicensis* ssp. *jamaicensis*), Red Knot (*Calidris canutus rufa*), Piping Plover (*Charadrius melodus*), and pondberry (*Lindera melissifolia*). Due to the limited scope of the project, it has been determined that this project will have "no effect" on these species.


The project will not have a discharge of dredged or fill material into waters of the United States; therefore, a Section 404 permit will not be required.

Tier 1 Categorical Exclusion Re-Evaluation

A Tier 1 Categorical Exclusion was completed for the subject job on May 29, 2020. Since that time, an ultra-thin bonded wearing course overlay of the I-55/I-555 Interchange ramps has been added to the project. In addition, two bridges have been removed from polymer overlay work. The new project length is 4.79 miles. All work will still take place within existing right of way. A project location map and updated SHPO clearance are attached.



#### Dear Secretary Hurst:

The Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) proposes to mill and inlay on the existing paved surface for different highways across the state. All work will occur inside the existing ARDOT right-of-way. Jobs with these types of activities are referred to as pavement preservation.

These activities are not covered by the existing 1999 Memorandum of Agreement when historic properties are on or adjacent to the project. As agreed upon during phone correspondence with Eric Mills on January 15, 2020, the table on the following page is presented to address the pavement preservation jobs with recorded historic properties and National Register of Historic Places unevaluated archeological sites, cemeteries, and bridges. It is ARDOT's opinion that these jobs have no potential to cause effect to historic properties pursuant to 36 CFR 800.3(1).
