



#### Administrative Cost Per Mile Arkansas Ranks 48th in the Nation




#### Administrative Cost as a Percent of Total Disbursements Arkansas Ranks 48th in the Nation










# Motor Vehicle Registration








### State Administered Highway User Revenues (Includes State Revenues Only)












#### Appropriations From/Payments Into the Federal Highway Trust Fund (FY 2012) Arkansas Ranks 32nd in the Nation






#### Public Road and Street Mileage Arkansas Ranks 18th in the Nation




#### State Highway Mileage Arkansas Ranks 12th in the Nation




#### Capital Outlay Disbursements Per Mile Arkansas Ranks 39th in the Nation




#### Maintenance Disbursements Per Mile Arkansas Ranks 41st in the Nation




#### Law Enforcement and Safety Disbursements Per Mile Arkansas Ranks 34th in the Nation



#### Total Disbursements for State Administered Highways Arkansas Ranks 35th in the Nation




#### Total Disbursements for State Administered Highways Per Mile Arkansas Ranks 41st in the Nation
