RUPPLE ROAD RECONSTRUCTION/RELOCATION
REQUEST FOR LETTER OF INTEREST

Notice is hereby given that the City of Fayetteville ("the City") is seeking Letters of Interest from qualified consulting firms to provide engineering related services for the reconstruction & relocation of Ruppel Road from Starry Night View to Mount Comfort Road including a new concrete bridge over Hamestring Creek.

The work will generally consist of providing environmental documentation, surveys, geotechnical studies, hydraulic studies, roadway and bridge design and plans, right of way plans, and construction engineering and inspection services.

This project includes federal funds along with review and approval of the work by the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD). All work and contract requirements shall conform to requirements of the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), AHTD and the City.

Interested firms must furnish a Letter of Interest listing primary contact information and Architect-Engineer Qualifications Form SF-330, Parts I and II. Eight (8) hard copies and one (1) digital copy in Adobe Acrobat PDF shall be submitted to:
