Notice is hereby given that the City of Jonesboro is seeking letters of interest from qualified consulting engineering firms to perform an origin-destination study to evaluate the potential impact of extending Parker Road to the Washington Avenue/Hwy. 63 interchange as a means of relieving traffic congestion from the Southwest Drive/Hwy. 63 interchange in Jonesboro, Arkansas.

The work will generally consist of data collection, analysis, and a final report.

This project includes federal funds along with review and approval of the work by the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD). All work and contract requirements shall conform to requirements of the Federal Highway Administration and AHTD.
