Notice is hereby given that the Arkansas Department of Transportation Department (Department) is seeking letters of interest from qualified firms for traffic counting activities on public roads in Arkansas. The services will be provided on an as-needed basis for calendar years 2020, 2021, and 2022.

The work will generally consist of the following:

- traffic volume counts,
- vehicle classification counts (with mechanical and video traffic counters),
- intersection turning movement counts with video traffic counters, and
- other traffic data collection as needs demand.

The consultant selection for this letter of interest will follow the Department's *Consultant Selection Procedures 12/14/2016*. After a review of all letters of interest received, selected firms will be furnished a scope of work and be requested to submit proposals for accomplishing the work. Final selection is anticipated to be announced following the Arkansas State Highway Commission action on September 4, 2019.
