## **6 COORDINATION AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT**

Involvement and participation by federal and state agencies, local public officials, and the general public was solicited for the development and direction of this project. This section describes the coordination and public involvement conducted throughout the MIS and EIS process. Tables 6-1, 6-2, and 6-3 contain a summary of information pertaining to the public meetings, public officials meetings, and agency meetings held for this project.

## 6.1 MAJOR INVESTMENT STUDY PROCESS

A Working Group for the MIS was formed of representatives from the following:

- 1) The cities and counties in the project area
- 2) The Northwest Arkansas Regional Airport Authority
- 3) The Federal Highway Administration
- 4) The Federal Transit Administration
- 5) The Northwest Arkansas Regional Planning Commission
- 6) The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department

This Group established public involvement procedures for the MIS process, and two public meetings were held to gather information from the public.

# 6.2 <u>NEEDS AND ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT/SCOPING PROCESS</u>

A total of 19 meetings were held as part of the DEIS/SDEIS public involvement process for this project; including two scoping meetings with state and federal resource agency representatives, eight with local public officials, seven public involvement or public hearings with the general public, and two neighborhood meetings. Information concerning these meetings is available in Tables 6-1, 6-2, and 6-3.

# 6.2.1 Agency Coordination

The USACE and the USFWS expressed a desire to be cooperating agencies in the preparation of the environmental impact statement. Copies of cooperating agency letters and coordination can be found in Appendix O. Information concerning agency scoping and coordination meetings can be found in Table 6-1.

## 6.2.2.1 Coordination with NWARA Access Road Project

An ongoing series of coordination meetings were held with representatives of the NWARA Access Road project. The purpose of the meetings was to coordinate the development of and exchange information between the two projects. These meetings involved officials and consultants for the NWARA Access Road, FHWA representatives, and AHTD personnel and are listed in Table 6-1.

## 6.2.2 **Public Meetings**

Three methods were used to notify the public of meetings, 1) press releases to all area newspapers, radio stations and television stations, 2) legal notices and/or display ads in newspapers, and 3) a project newsletter. All public meetings offered the public the opportunity to be placed on the project mailing list. As each meeting was held or inquiries were received, names were added. The current list contains over 1,100 names. The newsletter and a web site were developed to make project information available to the public about the environmental impact study process and the evolution and status of the project.

All of the public meetings held for this project had a similar open house format. AHTD representatives were available to explain the displays and provide information. A flowchart presented a simplified outline of the overall project process. Exhibits with aerial photography and street map bases were utilized to demonstrate project-related information. Handouts were used to convey additional "take-home" information.

Comment sheets were used to encourage contributions from the public. They were designed to obtain information about and public response to the project. To encourage participation by citizens unable to attend the scheduled meetings, copies of the maps were provided to cities in the area. Aerial photography and map displays from the meetings were also available afterward at the local AHTD offices. Information concerning the Public Meetings can be found in Table 6-2.

#### **6.2.2.1** Hispanic Community Public Involvement

In an effort to engage the Hispanic community in the public involvement process for the SDEIS, an AHTD Hispanic Public Involvement specialist met with some of the Hispanic community members of northwest Arkansas to determine the best way to reach the Hispanic community. After discussion with these local leaders, a public involvement meeting was held at the Jones Center for Families, a location convenient for the Hispanic community. The meeting date and time was carefully selected to avoid conflicts with local Hispanic events, and scheduled on a weekend so that conflicts with work times would be minimized.

The information presented was the same as that utilized at the other general public involvements, except that Spanish translations were used and Spanish-speaking personnel were available. A slide show presentation was also available in Spanish.

#### 6.2.3 Local Officials' Coordination

Before each series of public meetings, invitations to both a Public Officials' Meeting and the public sessions were sent to mayors of cities, county judges, state legislative officials and others in the project area. The Public Officials' Meeting was held prior to the public sessions

and gave the local officials an opportunity to preview the information being shown to the public. Information concerning the Public Officials' Meetings can be found in Table 6-3.

## 6.2.5 DEIS Location Public Hearing-May 2003

A DEIS Location Public Hearing was held to obtain formal comment on the draft environmental impact statement. Aerial photographs and maps were again used as exhibits to show the changes made to the alignment alternatives. Handouts were used to provide the public with an overview of the project and its history. A copy of the meeting handout, comment sheet, and a synopsis and analysis of the public meetings are found in Appendix A.

## 6.2.6 SDEIS Review

The USACE and USFWS, as cooperating agencies, reviewed and commented on a draft copy of the SDEIS. The comments received as a result of that review are included in Section 7, Comment and Reply. Other reviewers included the Interdisciplinary Staff at the AHTD, and a Multi-disciplinary Staff at the Arkansas Division of the FHWA.

Copies of the final SDEIS were delivered to federal and state agencies, U.S. and State legislators, local officials, and other applicable organizations. The distribution list can be found in Section 8 of the SDEIS. Copies were also made available at the Springdale Public Library for public use, and the SDEIS or an Executive Summary was made available upon request.

## 6.2.7 SDEIS Public Hearing-June 2004

A SDEIS Location Public Hearing was held to obtain formal comment on the supplemental draft environmental impact statement. Aerial photographs and maps were again used as exhibits to show the changes made to the alignment alternatives. Handouts were used to provide the public with an overview of the project and its history. A copy of the meeting handout, comment sheet, and a synopsis and analysis of the public meetings are found in Appendix A.

#### 6.2.8 Western Terminus Public Involvement Meeting-September 2004

A public meeting was held to obtain comment on a change to the western terminus of the preferred alternative. Aerial photographs and maps were used as exhibits to show the changes made to the western interchange with existing Hwy 412 and the proposed alignment shift south of Brush Creek Road. Handouts were used to provide the public with a small-scale map of the changes to the preferred alignment. A copy of the meeting handout, comment sheet, and a synopsis and analysis of these public involvement meetings are found in Appendix A.
