### **AHTD TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING IN MONTICELLO**

**LITTLE ROCK (8-31)** The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) will hold a Design Public Hearing in Monticello to discuss proposed plans for a bypass of Monticello on Highway 278, according to AHTD officials.

Plans call for a bypass around the south side of town. The meeting is being held to discuss the phase of the project that would extend from Highway 278, east of town, southward to Highway 425.

The meeting will be held on Tuesday, September 8<sup>th</sup> from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the Sadie Johnson Community Center, 182 N. Larkin Drive, in Monticello.
