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ARKANSAS STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION OPENS BIDS FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN SEVIER COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (5-20) -- The Arkansas State Highway Commission has opened bids for improvements to a roadway in Sevier County, according to Commission Chairman Carl Rosenbaum of Little Rock.

The purpose of the project is to resurface one mile of Highway 70 near DeQueen. R.K. Hall Construction, LTD of Paris, Texas, was awarded the contract at \$382,750.30.

"This resurfacing project will begin at DeQueen and will extend westward on Highway 70," stated Rosenbaum.

Rosenbaum said work could begin on the project in two to four weeks, weather permitting. Completion is expected by September 14, 2009.

The project is being funded with money provided by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA). The Act provided Arkansas with \$351 million in federal stimulus funds for roadway and bridge improvements throughout the state.
