ARKANSAS STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION OPENS BIDS FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN SCOTT COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (4-16) -- The Arkansas State Highway Commission has opened bids for improvements to a roadway in Scott County, according to Commissioner Dick Trammel of Rogers and Scott County Judge James Forbes.

The purpose of the project is to construct a bridge on County Road 76 over Square Rock Creek. Crawford Construction Company of Fort Smith, Arkansas, was awarded the contract at \$449,773.70.

“This project is located in Waldron and will make this a safer roadway for motorists in the area,” stated Judge Forbes.

Trammel noted that the County Road project is funded through the State Aid Road Program established by the legislature and administered by the State Aid Division of the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department. This program provides approximately \$20 million annually from the state motor fuels tax to assist counties with projects of their choosing on the county road system.

Trammel said work could begin on the project in six to eight weeks, weather permitting. Completion is expected in the summer of 2010.
