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ARKANSAS STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION OPENS BIDS FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN LAFAYETTE COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (5-20) -- The Arkansas State Highway Commission has opened bids for improvements to a roadway in Lafayette County, according to Commission Chairman Carl Rosenbaum of Little Rock and Lafayette County Judge Frank Scroggins.

The purpose of the project is to resurface approximately ten miles of County Roads 27 and 32, near Lewisville. C & F Construction Company, Inc. of Smackover, Arkansas, was awarded the contract at \$249,454.98.

“Keeping our county road system in good condition is always a top priority,” stated Judge Scroggins.

Rosenbaum noted that the County Road project is funded through the State Aid Road Program established by the legislature and administered by the State Aid Division of the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department. This program provides approximately \$20 million annually from the state motor fuels tax to assist counties with projects of their choosing on the county road system.

Rosenbaum said work could begin on the project in two to four weeks, weather permitting. Completion is expected in the fall of 2009.

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
