ARKANSAS STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION OPENS BIDS FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN LONOKE COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (5-20) -- The Arkansas State Highway Commission has opened bids for improvements to a roadway in Lonoke County, according to Commission Chairman Carl Rosenbaum of Little Rock.

The purpose of the project is to resurface 7.25 miles of Highway 165, in the area of Scott. XXX of XXX, was awarded the contract at \$XXX.

“This resurfacing project will begin at Highway 386 and continue westward to Highway 391 in Pulaski County,” stated Rosenbaum.

Rosenbaum said work could begin on the project in six to eight weeks, weather permitting. Completion is expected by September 14, 2009.

The project is being funded with money provided by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA). The Act provides Arkansas with \$351 million in federal stimulus funds for roadway and bridge improvements throughout the state.
