Highway 64 Resurfacing at Alma

FORT SMITH (4-Sep) The Contractor has informed the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department District Four Headquarters at Fort Smith of the following lane closures associated with work on 2 miles of Highway 64, from west of Highway 162 to the east city limits in Alma.

- From Monday, September 8, through Friday, September 18, traffic will be restricted to one lane between the hours of 6 p.m. and 6 a.m. to allow the contractor to coldmill and overlay the existing roadway surface. Traffic control will be provided to allow alternating eastbound and westbound traffic to use one lane.

Adjustment of the times of any announced lane closures may become necessary due to weather or other unforeseen conditions.

Motorists are reminded that delays may be expected in the area of the work. Motorists are also urged to use caution when traveling through the work zone. Motorists should remember to Obey the Posted Speeds; to Leave Room between them and other vehicles; and to Be Aware of Road Conditions in front of them.

The Arkansas Highway Commission awarded a contract in the amount of \$717,562 to Forsgren, Inc. in July 2009 for the resurfacing of this section Highway 64.
