MAINTENANCE WORK ON INTERSTATE 40 TO REQUIRE LANE CLOSURE IN NORTH LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (1-15) Crews replacing reflective lenses on the raised pavement markers on Interstate 40 in the Burns Park area of North Little Rock will require lane closures beginning next week, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The lane closures will be located on Interstate 40, between the Interstate 430 interchange and the Interstate 30 interchange.

The work will require the eastbound, outside lane to be closed for approximately one mile beginning on January 20th. As work progresses, intermittent outside and inside lane closures will be in effect in the eastbound and westbound lanes, however, two lanes will remain open in each direction at all times during the work. The project will continue for approximately four weeks. Lane closures will be in effect from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Motorists should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
