LANE CLOSURES SCHEDULED FOR NEXT WEEK

LITTLE ROCK (4-9) Lane closures are scheduled on two major Interstates in Central Arkansas next week, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews replacing lenses on reflective pavement markers will require a lane closure on Interstate 630 in Little Rock (Milemarker 4 to 7). The work will require the eastbound, outside lane to be closed Monday, April 12th, weather permitting. The lane closure will be in effect from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Also scheduled next week are two lane closures on Interstate 30.

Crews replacing asphalt will require a lane closure south of Benton (Milemarker 108 to 108.5). The westbound, outside lane will be closed on Tuesday, April 13th, weather permitting. The lane closure will be in effect from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Asphalt replacement will also require a lane closure on Interstate 30 on Wednesday, April 14th, weather permitting. The eastbound, inside lane will be closed, south of Benton, (Milemarker 112 to 113) from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Motorists should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
