IMPROVEMENTS TO CLOSE HIGHWAY 46 IN GRANT COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (5-27) The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) will begin a project to replace pipe culverts on Highway 46, between Sheridan and Redfield, on Monday, June 14th. The work will require the highway to be closed during construction hours.

The site is located 7.2 miles southwest of Redfield and 8.8 miles northeast of Sheridan (approximately .3 miles north of Grant County Road 4608). (See map.)

The work at this location requires the replacement of a set of five large cross drains and will require the closing of the highway to through traffic from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. each day starting Monday, June 14th, and continuing through Thursday, June 17th, weather permitting. Work will continue the following week, with the highway being closed to through traffic from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday, as necessary. The highway will be reopened to traffic each evening and on weekends.

The work is anticipated to be completed in approximately two weeks, weather permitting. Motorists traveling between Redfield and Sheridan should use either Highway 270 or Highway 167 in lieu of Highway 46 while improvements are underway.
