HIGHWAY 146 AT PRESTON FERRY TO BE CLOSED FOR IMPROVEMENTS BEGINNING JULY 19TH

LITTLE ROCK (7-1) The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) will begin a project to replace pipe culverts on Highway 146 at Preston Ferry, in the Casscoe community, on Monday, July 19th, according to AHTD officials.

The site is located 1.2 miles east of the junction of Highways 33 and 146 (just west of Taylor Lane).

The work at this location requires the replacement of a large cross drain and will require the closing of the highway to through traffic from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. daily starting Monday, July 19th. The work is anticipated to be complete in approximately three days, weather permitting. The highway will be reopened to traffic each evening.
