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ARKANSAS STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION OPENS BIDS FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN JEFFERSON COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (7-13) -- The Arkansas State Highway Commission has opened bids for improvements to a roadway in Jefferson County, according to Commission Vice Chairman R. Madison Murphy of El Dorado.

The purpose of the project is to install upgraded traffic signals on Highway 65B in Pine Bluff. L.E.G. Enterprises, Inc. of Cabot, Arkansas, was awarded the contract at \$274,643.34.

“The new upgraded signals will replace those at the intersections of Highway 65B and Walnut, and Highway 65B and Convention Center Drive,” stated Murphy.

The project is being funded with money provided by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA). The Act provided Arkansas with \$351 million in federal stimulus funds for roadway and bridge improvements throughout the state. Murphy said work could begin on the project in two to four weeks, weather permitting. Completion is expected in early 2011.

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
