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### IMPROVEMENTS TO INTERSTATE 30 IN PULASKI COUNTY TO REQUIRE LANE CLOSURE

**LITTLE ROCK (5-20)** -- Crews performing repairs to a median wall and to a guardrail will require lane closures next week on Interstate 30, near downtown Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

A lane closure to repair a guardrail will be located near the 6<sup>th</sup>/9<sup>th</sup> Street Exit (Mile Marker 142 to 143) and will require the westbound, inside lane to be closed on Monday, May 23<sup>rd</sup>. The lane closure will be in effect between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting.

A second lane closure, to repair a median wall and light pole foundations, will be located on Interstate 30 in the vicinity of Roosevelt Road (Mile Marker 138 to 140). It will require the eastbound, inside lane to be closed beginning Monday, May 23<sup>rd</sup> and continuing through Thursday, May 26<sup>th</sup>. This lane closure will be in effect between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. each day, weather permitting.

Motorists should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.

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
