LITTLE ROCK (9-21) The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) will hold a Design Public Hearing in Searcy to discuss plans for an extension of Highway 13.

The meeting will be held on Tuesday, October 4th, from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at Valley Baptist Church, 3328 Highway 36 West, in Searcy.

Plans call for constructing an extension of Highway 13, southwest of Searcy, that would extend from Highway 267 northward to Highway 36.
