AHTD TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETINGS IN SPRINGDALE AND ROGERS

LITTLE ROCK (10-5) The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) will hold two Public Involvement Meetings, in Springdale and in Rogers, to discuss plans for a proposed North-South highway corridor in the area east of the two cities.

The first meeting will be held in Springdale on Tuesday, October 18th, from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at The Jones Center for Families, Rooms 221 & 228, 922 East Emma Avenue.

The second meeting will be held in Rogers on Wednesday, October 19th, from 4:00 to 7:00 p.m. in the Rogers Heritage High School cafeteria, 1114 S. 5th Street.

Plans call for constructing a north-south corridor extending from Highway 16, in southeast Fayetteville, northward to Highway 62, in northeast Rogers.
