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ARKANSAS STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION OPENS BIDS FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN SEVIER COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (7-20) -- The Arkansas State Highway Commission has opened bids for improvements to roadways in Sevier County, according to Commissioner Tom Schueck of Little Rock and Sevier County Judge Greg Ray.

The purpose of the project is to resurface approximately 3.75 miles of Oak Grove Road (County Road 2), near Oak Grove, and Farm to Market Road (County Road 15), near DeQueen. Spa Construction Company, Inc. of Hot Springs, Arkansas, was awarded the contract at \$197,270.71.

“These improvements will mean safer travel for motorists traveling in these areas of Sevier County,” stated Judge Ray.

Schueck noted that the County Road project is funded through the State Aid Road Program established by the legislature and administered by the State Aid Division of the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department. This program provides approximately \$20 million annually from the state motor fuels tax to assist counties with projects of their choosing on the county road system.

Schueck said work could begin on the project in two to four weeks, weather permitting. Completion is expected in September of this year.

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
