## ARKANSAS STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION OPENS BIDS FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN JEFFERSON COUNTY

**LITTLE ROCK** (1-12) -- The Arkansas State Highway Commission has opened bids for improvements to a roadway in Jefferson County, according to Commission Chairman R. Madison Murphy of El Dorado.

The purpose of the project is to improve the intersection of Highway 190 and East Harding Drive in Pine Bluff. Construction Management & Maintenance, Inc. of North Little Rock, Arkansas, was awarded the contract at \$277,000.

"Improvements to the intersection include an upgraded traffic signal, wheelchair ramps, crosswalks and some resurfacing," stated Murphy. In addition, the travel lanes at the intersection have been slightly realigned to better accommodate turning movements," stated Murphy.

The project is being funded with money provided by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA). The Act provided Arkansas with \$351 million in federal stimulus funds for roadway and bridge improvements throughout the state. Murphy said work could begin on the project in two to four weeks, weather permitting. Completion is expected in September of 2011.

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
