ARKANSAS STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION OPENS BIDS FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN PULASKI AND LONOKE COUNTIES

LITTLE ROCK (2-28) -- The Arkansas State Highway Commission has opened bids for improvements to a roadway in Pulaski and Lonoke counties, according to Commissioner Tom Schueck of Little Rock.

The purpose of the project is to install a median cable barrier on approximately five miles of Highway 67. Nationwide Construction Group of Chesterfield, Michigan, was awarded the contract at \$1,166,172.18.

“This new cable barrier will be located between the cities of Jacksonville and Cabot,” stated Schueck. “These barriers have proven to be very effective in preventing crossover accidents,” Schueck adds. “Once installed, this new fence will improve the safety of motorists traveling Highway 67 between Cabot and Jacksonville.”

Schueck said work could begin on the project in two to four weeks, weather permitting. Completion is expected this summer.
