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ARKANSAS STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION OPENS BIDS FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN FRANKLIN COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (4-13) -- The Arkansas State Highway Commission has opened bids for improvements to roadways in Franklin County, according to Commissioner Dick Trammel of Rogers.

The purpose of the first project is to resurface approximately 1.5 miles of Highway 23, near the town of White Oak. Blackstone Construction, LLC of Russellville, Arkansas, was awarded the contract at \$281,430.36.

“This project will begin at North White Oak Creek and continue northward,” stated Trammel.

A second project will resurface 1.75 miles of Highway 64 in the vicinity of Altus. Blackstone Construction, LLC of Russellville, Arkansas, was awarded the contract at \$446,650.20.

Trammel said work could begin on the projects in two to four weeks, weather permitting. Completion is expected on both in September of this year.

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
