### ARKANSAS HIGHWAY COMMISSION APPROVES BID FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN CRITTENDEN & CROSS COUNTIES

**LITTLE ROCK (9-17)** - The Arkansas State Highway Commission approved a bid for improvements to roadways in Crittenden & Cross counties, according to the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The purpose of the project is to resurface 1.8 miles of 5 roadways in Earle, 1.3 miles of 3 roadways in Parkin, and 0.7 miles of 2 roadways in Wynne. The work will be performed on the following streets.

M&T Paving & Construction Co., Inc. of Forrest City, AR was awarded the contract at \$689,660.20.

Construction is scheduled to begin in two to four weeks, weather permitting. The project should be complete by the end of this year.

This project is being funded through the State Aid City Streets Program approved by lawmakers in 2011 and voters in 2012. This program provides \$20 million annually from the state motor fuels tax to assist cities with projects selected by a nine-member panel of Arkansas mayors.
