ARKANSAS HIGHWAY COMMISSION APPROVES BID FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN CALHOUN COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (7-29) -- The Arkansas State Highway Commission approved a bid for improvements to a roadway in Calhoun County, according to the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials and County Judge Floyd Nutt.

The purpose of the project is to replace a drainage structure on County Road 38 in Calhoun County.

The work on will be performed on County Road 38 at Jolly Creek, just south of County Road 37.

Calhoun County of Hampton, AR was awarded the contract at \$53,975.00.

This county road project is funded through the State Aid Road Program established by the legislature and administered by the State Aid Division of the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department. This Program provides approximately \$20 million annually from the state motor fuels tax to assist counties with projects of their choosing on the county road system.

Construction is scheduled to begin in two to four weeks, weather permitting. The project will be complete this fall.
