ARKANSAS HIGHWAY COMMISSION APPROVES BID FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN CLEBURNE & STONE COUNTIES

LITTLE ROCK (7-29) -- The Arkansas State Highway Commission approved a bid for improvements to a roadway in Cleburne and Stone Counties, according to the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials and Cleburne County Judge Jerry Holmes and Stone County Judge Stacey Avey.

The purpose of the project is to surface 0.15 mile of County Road 34 (Five Mile Road) in Cleburne and Stone County.

The work on County Road 34 (Five Mile Road) will extend from just south of Five Mile Loop to 0.2 miles north of the Cleburne/Stone County line.

Delta Asphalt of Arkansas, Inc. of Paragould, AR was awarded the contract at \$347,106.94.

This county road project is funded through the State Aid Road Program established by the legislature and administered by the State Aid Division of the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department. This Program provides approximately \$20 million annually from the state motor fuels tax to assist counties with projects of their choosing on the county road system.

Construction is scheduled to begin in two to four weeks, weather permitting. The project will be complete this fall.
