ARKANSAS HIGHWAY COMMISSION APPROVES BID FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN MARION COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (7-29) -- The Arkansas State Highway Commission approved a bid for improvements to a roadway in Marion County, according to the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The purpose of the project is to resurface 2.1 miles of roadways in Bull Shoals.

The work will be performed on Rivercliff Drive. It will extend from Highway 178 (Bull Shoals Dam Boulevard) to Highway 178 (Central Boulevard).

Twin Lakes Quarries, Inc. of Mountain Home, AR was awarded the contract at \$192,758.40.

This project is being funded through the State Aid City Streets Program approved by lawmakers in 2011 and voters in 2012. This program provides \$20 million annually from the state motor fuels tax to assist cities with projects selected by a nine-member panel of Arkansas mayors.

Construction is scheduled to begin in two to four weeks, weather permitting. The project will be complete this fall.
