ARKANSAS HIGHWAY COMMISSION APPROVES BID FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN RANDOLPH COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (7-29) -- The Arkansas State Highway Commission approved a bid for improvements to a roadway in Randolph County, according to the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials and County Judge David Jansen.

The purpose of the project is to resurface .6 mile of County Road 34 (Pettit Road) in Randolph County.

The work on County Road 34 (Pettit Road) will extend west from Engelberg Road, north of Pocahontas.

Atlas Asphalt, Inc. of Batesville, AR was awarded the contract at \$77,695.32.

This county road project is funded through the State Aid Road Program established by the legislature and administered by the State Aid Division of the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department. This Program provides approximately \$20 million annually from the state motor fuels tax to assist counties with projects of their choosing on the county road system.

Construction is scheduled to begin in two to four weeks, weather permitting. The project will be complete this fall.

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LITTLE ROCK (7-29) -- The Arkansas State Highway Commission approved a bid for improvements to a roadway in Randolph County, according to the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials and County Judge David Jansen.

The purpose of the project is to reseal 4.8 miles of County Roads 15 and 25 in Randolph County.

The work on County Road 15 (Oak Ridge Road) will extend northwards 3.1 miles from Highway 90.

The work on County Road 25 (Country Club Road) will extend from Highway 251 to just north of Navy Drive, north of Pocahontas.

Atlas Asphalt, Inc. of Batesville, AR was awarded the contract at \$122,733.34.

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Construction is scheduled to begin in two to four weeks, weather permitting. The project will be complete by this fall.

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
