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ARKANSAS HIGHWAY COMMISSION APPROVES BIDS FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN CLARK COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (6-10) -- The Arkansas State Highway Commission approved bids for improvements to roadways in Clark County, according to highway officials and County Judge Ron Daniell.

The purpose of the project is to resurface 6.8 miles of County Road 22 (Fendley Road). The work will be performed from Highway 8 to County Road 58 (Brushy Road).

Salt Creek Paving & Construction Co., Inc. of Benton, Arkansas was awarded the contract at \$161,675.98.

Construction is scheduled to begin in two to four weeks, weather permitting. The project should be complete by this fall.

This county road project is funded through the State Aid Road Program established by the legislature and administered by the State Aid Division of the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department. This program provided approximately \$20 million annually from the state motor fuels tax to assist counties with projects of their choosing on the county road system.

A second project will resurface 13 miles of Highway 8 west of Arkadelphia. The work will be performed from Highway 53 to Highway 51.

Redstone Construction Group, Inc of Little Rock, Arkansas was awarded the contract at \$3,360,353.29.

Construction is scheduled to begin in two to four weeks, weather permitting. The project should be complete by this fall.
