ARKANSAS HIGHWAY COMMISSION APPROVES BID FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN IZARD COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (6-10) -- The Arkansas State Highway Commission approved a bid for improvements to a roadway in Izard County.

The purpose of the project is to resurface 3.9 miles of Highways 9 and 9 Spur.

The work on Highway 9 will be performed from just north of Pine Ridge Road to .3 miles north of Dry Hollow Road, north of Brockwell. It's the equivalent of 3 miles.

Additional paving will be performed on Highway 9 from .2 mile south of Highway 56 to .5 mile north of Senior Center Road, south of Brockwell. It's the equivalent of .3 mile.

Paving will also be performed on Highway 9 from just south of Newburg Road to just south of Byrum Circle, south of Brockwell. It's the equivalent of .4 mile.

The work on Highway 9 Spur will be performed from West Main to the Melbourne Water Plant.

Atlas Asphalt, Inc of Batesville, Arkansas was awarded the contract at \$534,517.37.

Construction is scheduled to begin in two to four weeks, weather permitting. The project should be complete by this fall.
