ARKANSAS HIGHWAY COMMISSION APPROVES BID FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN BRADLEY COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (11-4) - The Arkansas State Highway Commission approved a bid for improvements to a roadway in Bradley County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials and County Judge Keith Neely.

The purpose of the project is to resurface 1.7 miles of County Road 2. The work will extend from just east of County Road 4 (Ingalls-Marsden Road) to just east of County Road 134.

R. Thompson, Inc. of Hamburg, Arkansas was awarded the contract at \$598,401.14.

Construction is scheduled to begin in two to four weeks, weather permitting. The project will be complete by summer 2014.

This county road project is funded through the State Aid Road Program established by the legislature and administered by the State Aid Division of the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department. This program provides approximately \$20 million annually from the state motor fuels tax to assist counties with projects of their choosing on the county road system.
