ARKANSAS STATE HIGHWAY AND TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT
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PAVING REQUIRES EARLY MORNING DETOUR ON I-40 IN PRAIRIE COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (6-11) – Paving at the west end of the White River Bridge on Interstate 40 in Prairie County will require a westbound traffic detour, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The detour will begin at 3:00 a.m. June 12th and conclude by 7:00 a.m. the same day. Westbound traffic will be detoured at Exit 202 (Biscoe) and routed south on State Highway 33 and continue west on U.S. Highway 70. Motorists will be routed back onto I-40 at Hazen (Exit 193).

Traffic will be controlled using warning signs and cones. Motorists should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
