AHTD to Hold Public Involvement Meeting in Magnolia

LITTLE ROCK (7-12) - The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) will hold a Public Involvement Meeting in Magnolia to discuss plans to widen 4.3 miles of Highway 82, from just south of the Highway 79 north and County Road 47 intersection in Magnolia, to County Road 525, east of Magnolia, according to AHTD officials.

The meeting will be held on Thursday, July 18th, from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., at Magnolia Christian Center (Life Center). It is located on the Highway 79/82 bypass, located just west of Highway 371, northwest of Magnolia.
